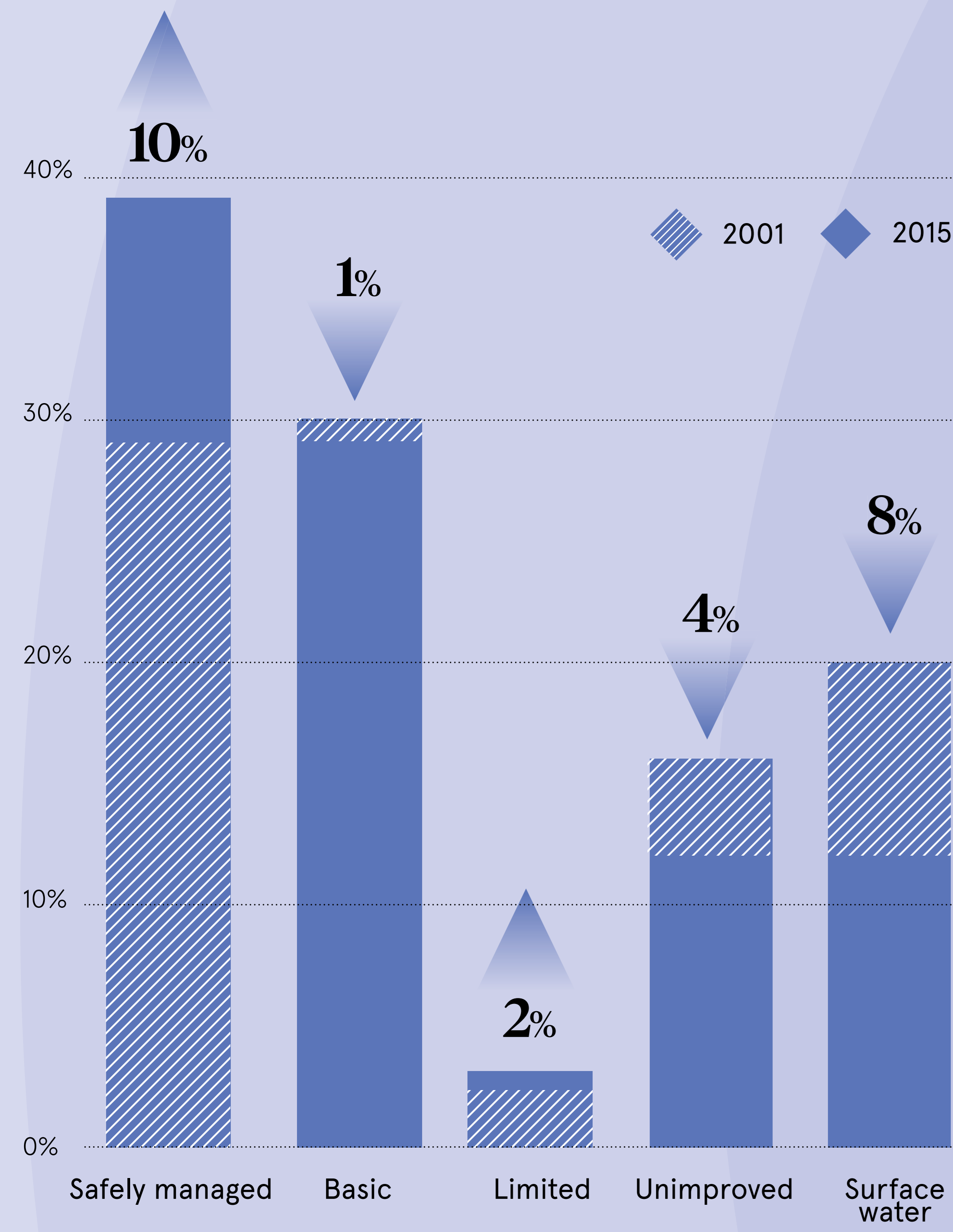

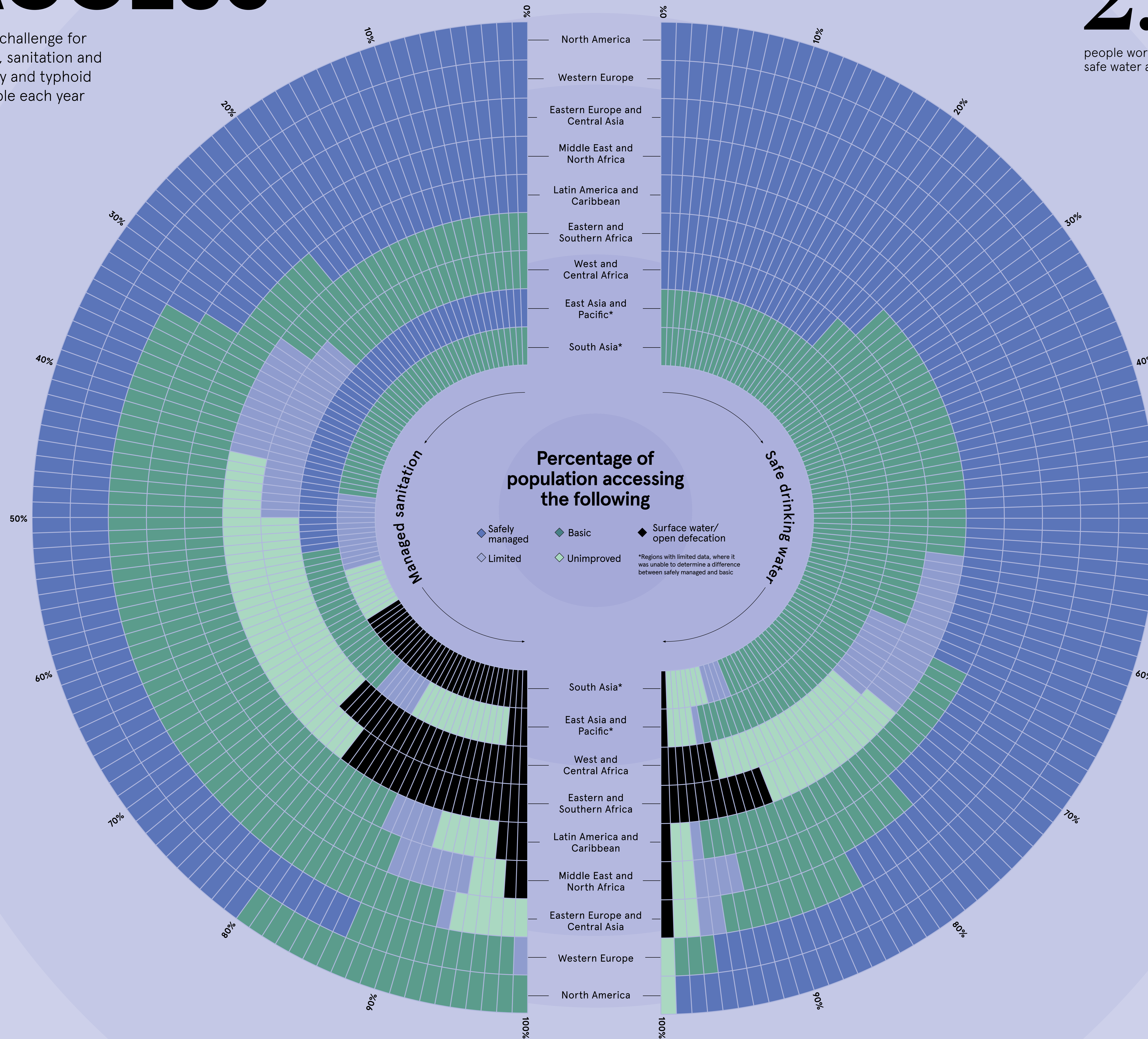
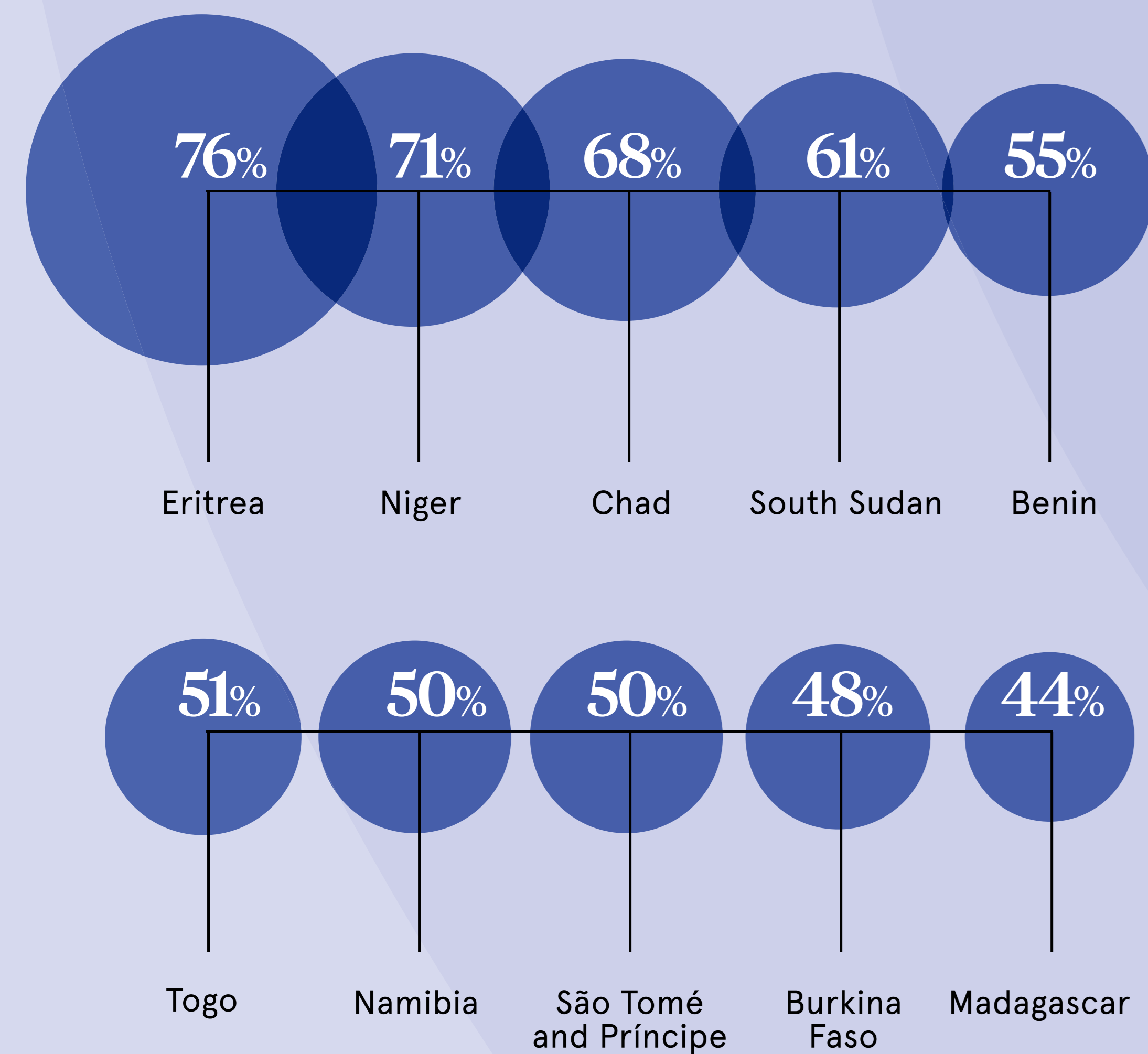
Global access to managed sanitation

Percentage of global population in 2015 accessing the following



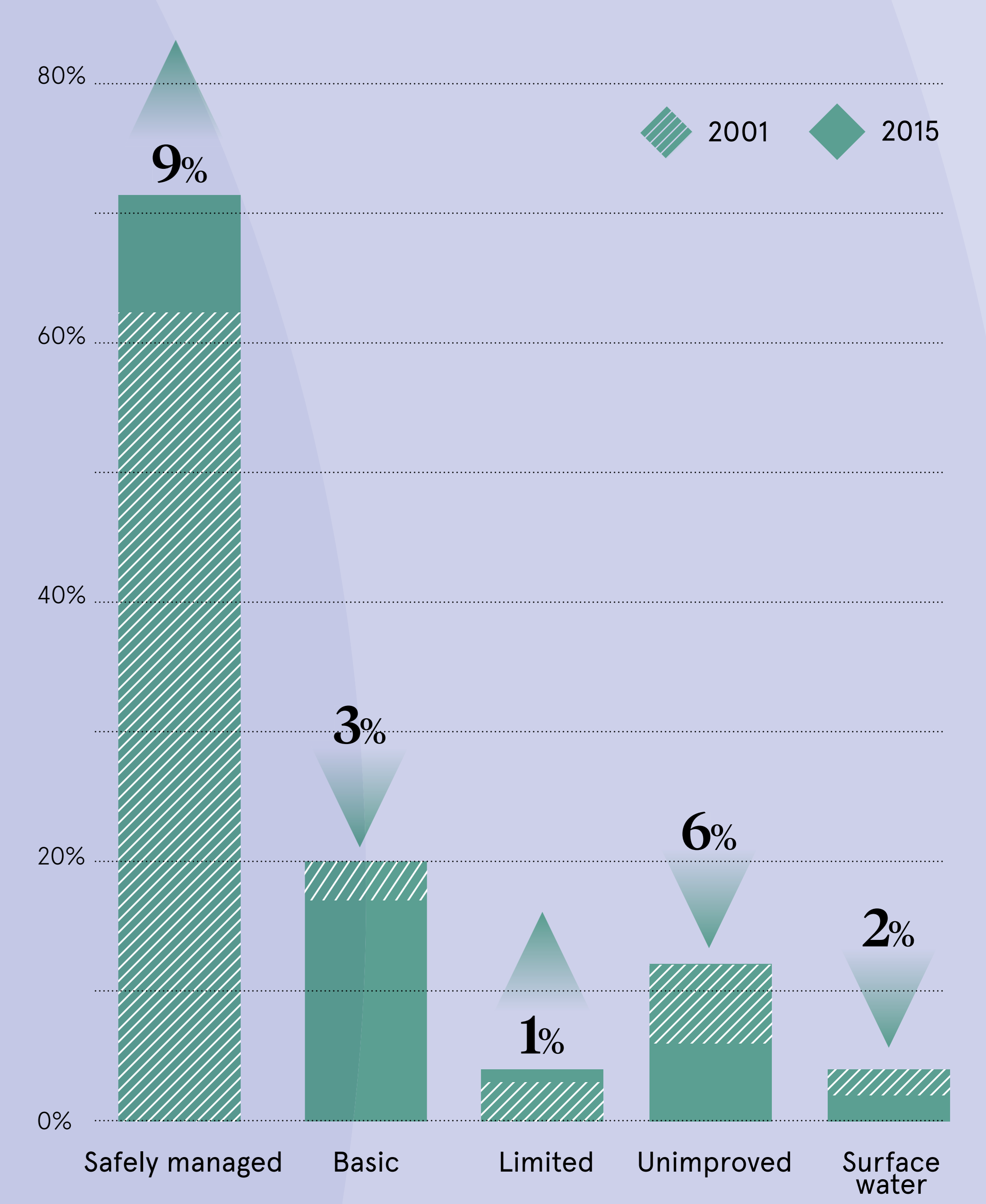
Worst countries for sanitation

Percentage of population who still defecate in the open



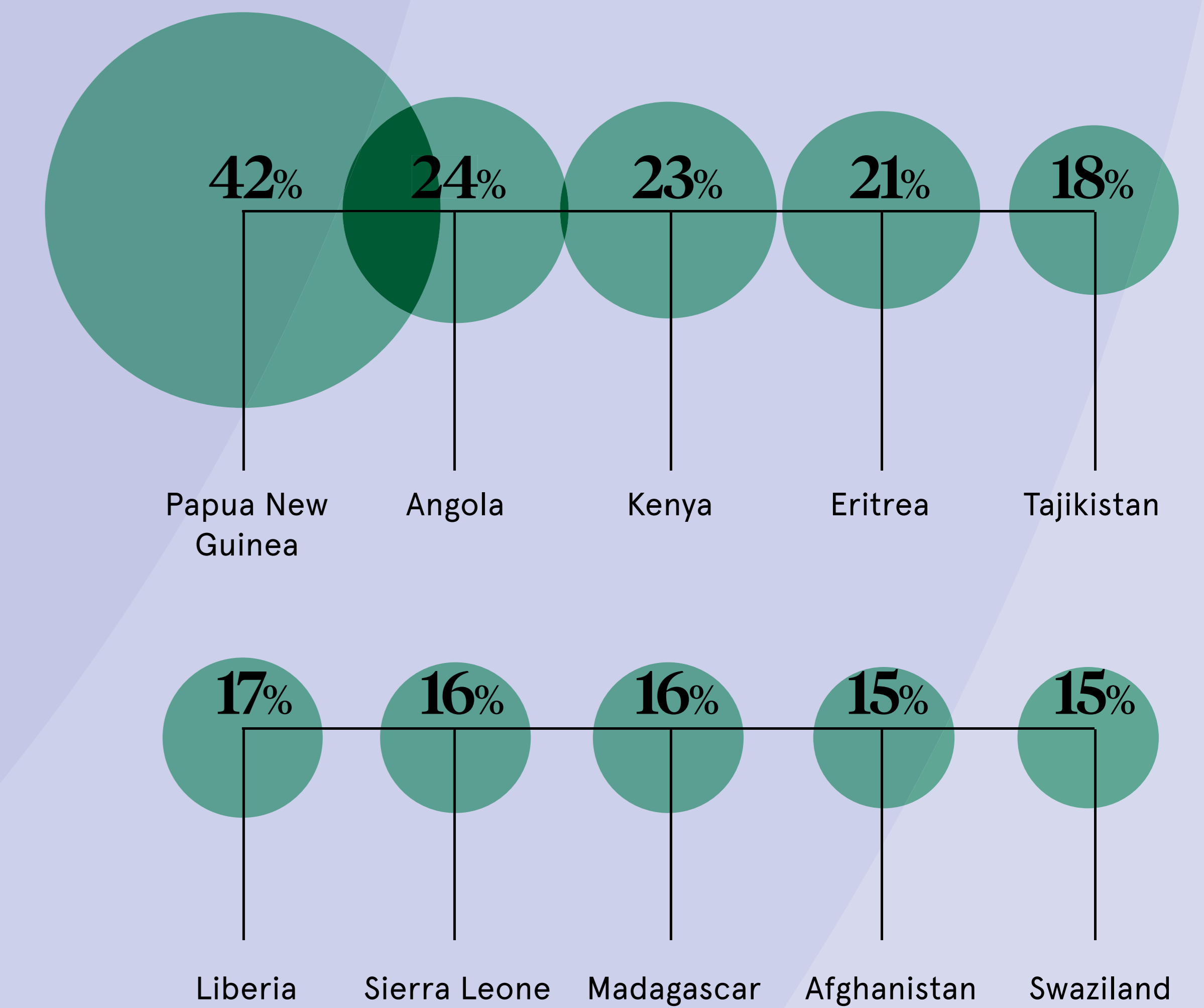
Global access to safe drinking water
