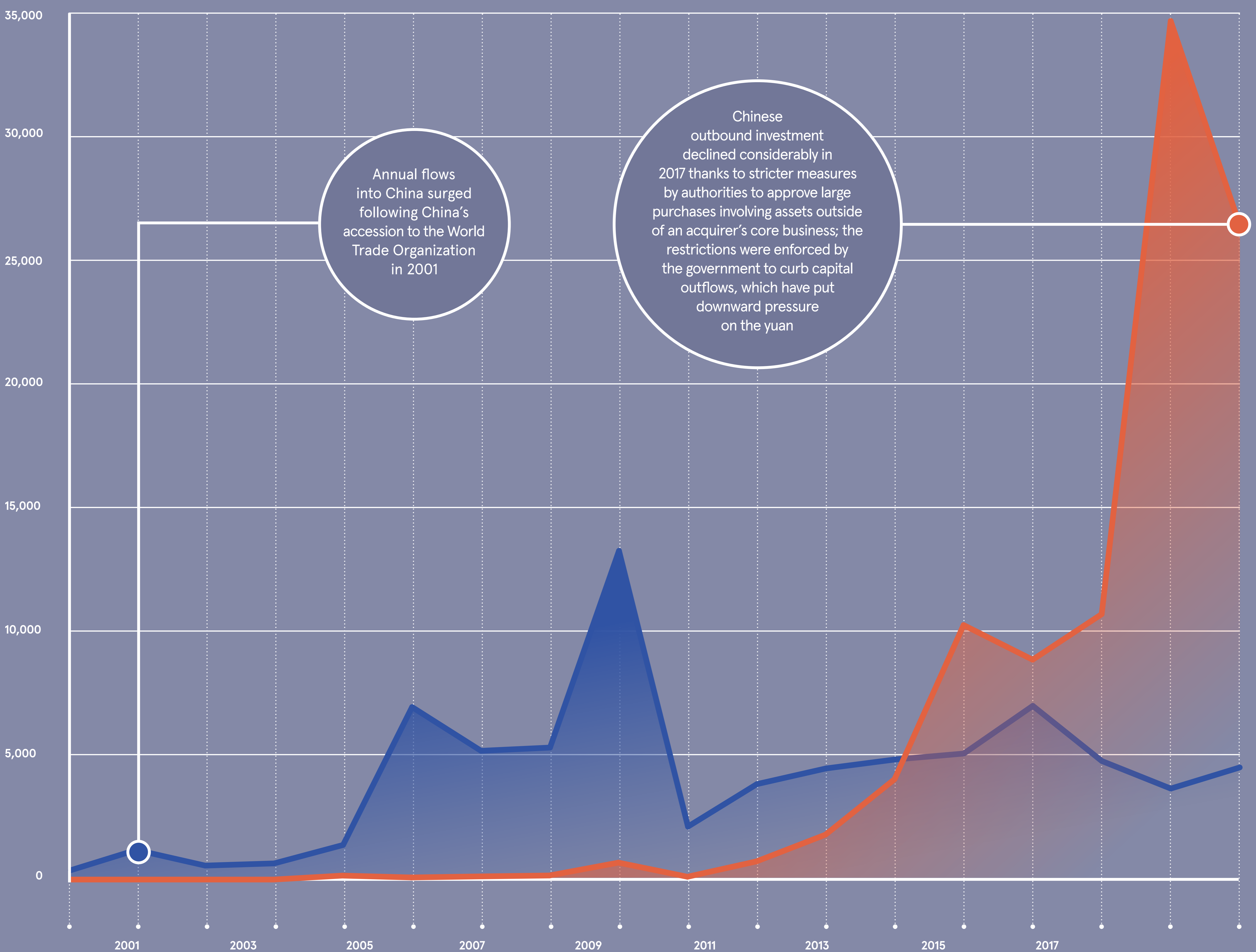

● US>China private acquisitions



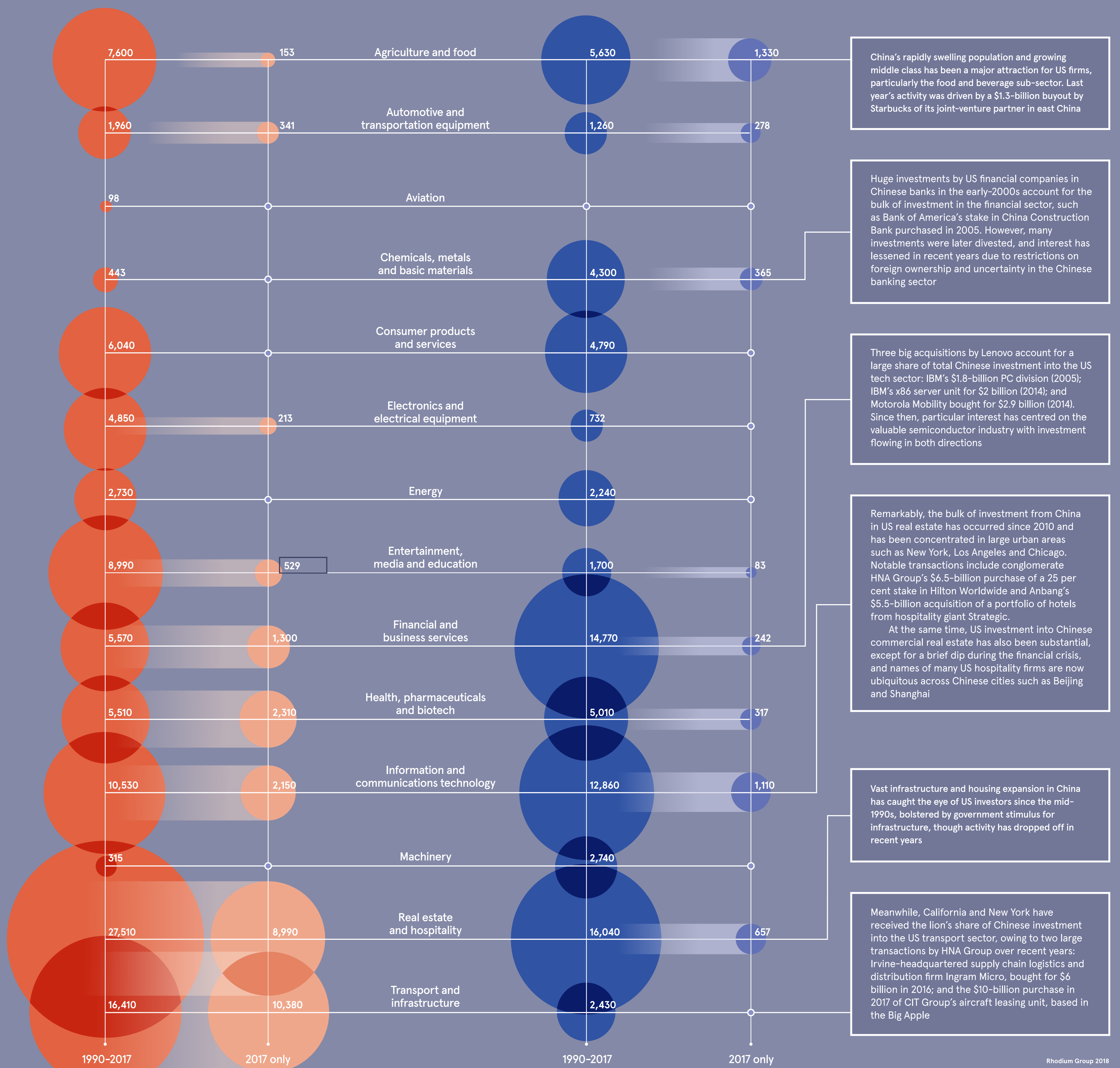
