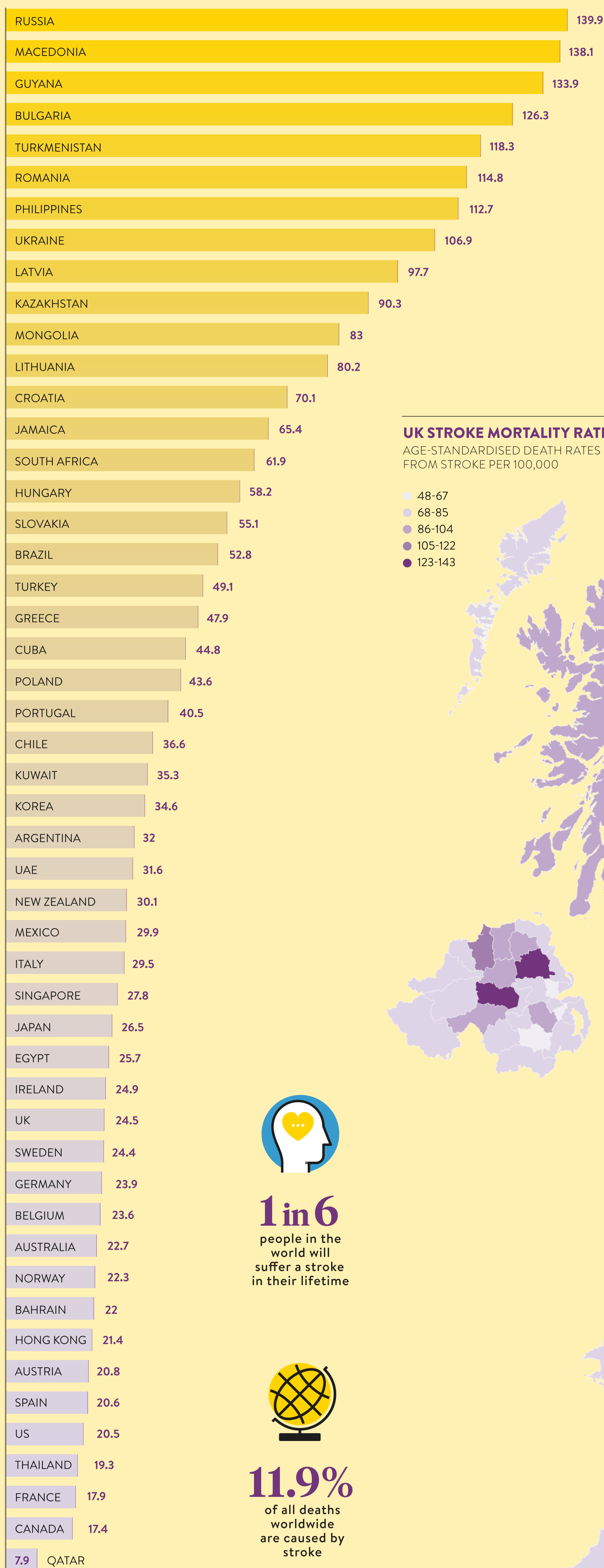

1 in 6 people in the world will suffer a stroke in their lifetime

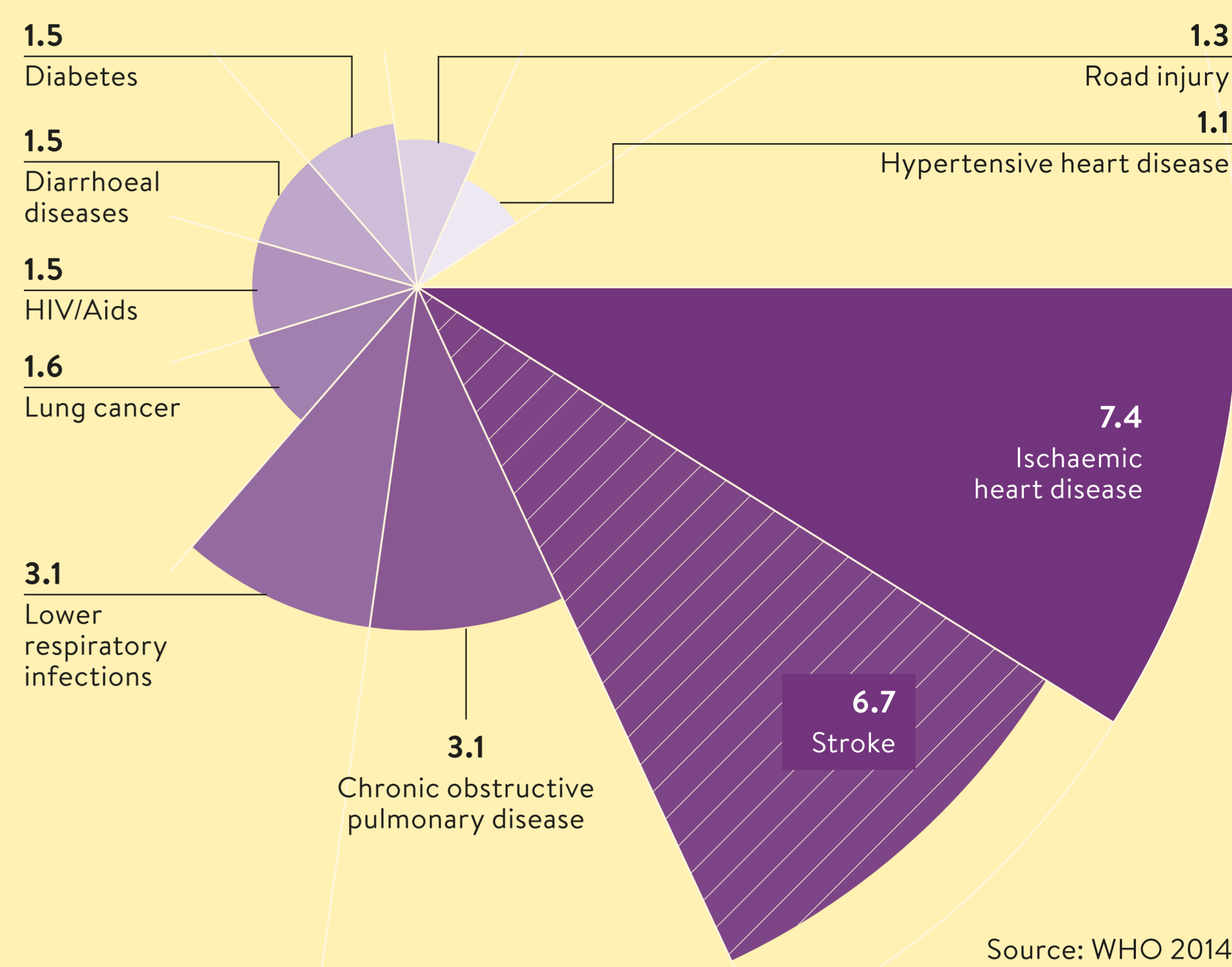


11.9% of all deaths worldwide are caused by stroke

BY NUMBER OF DEATHS IN MILLIONS

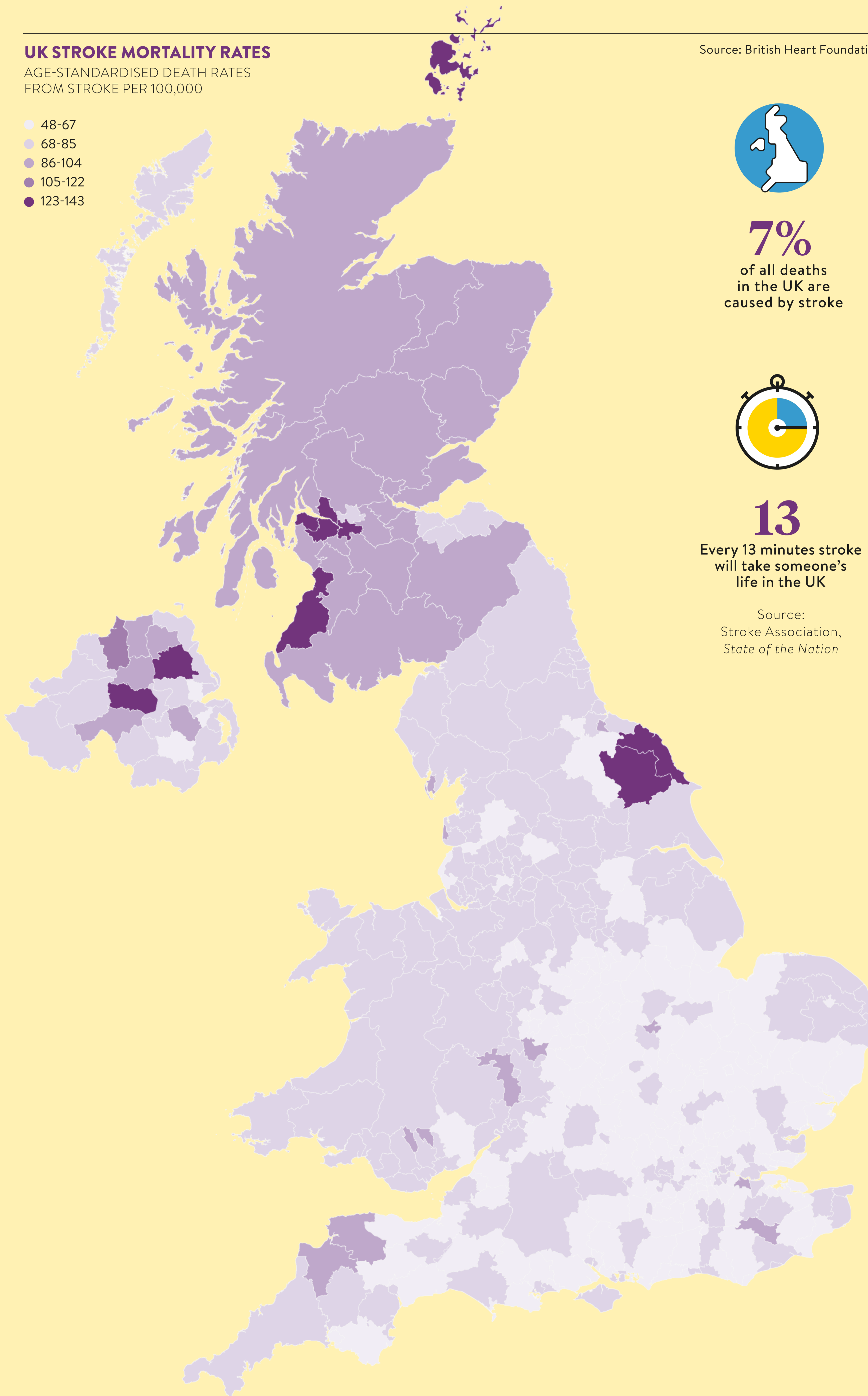

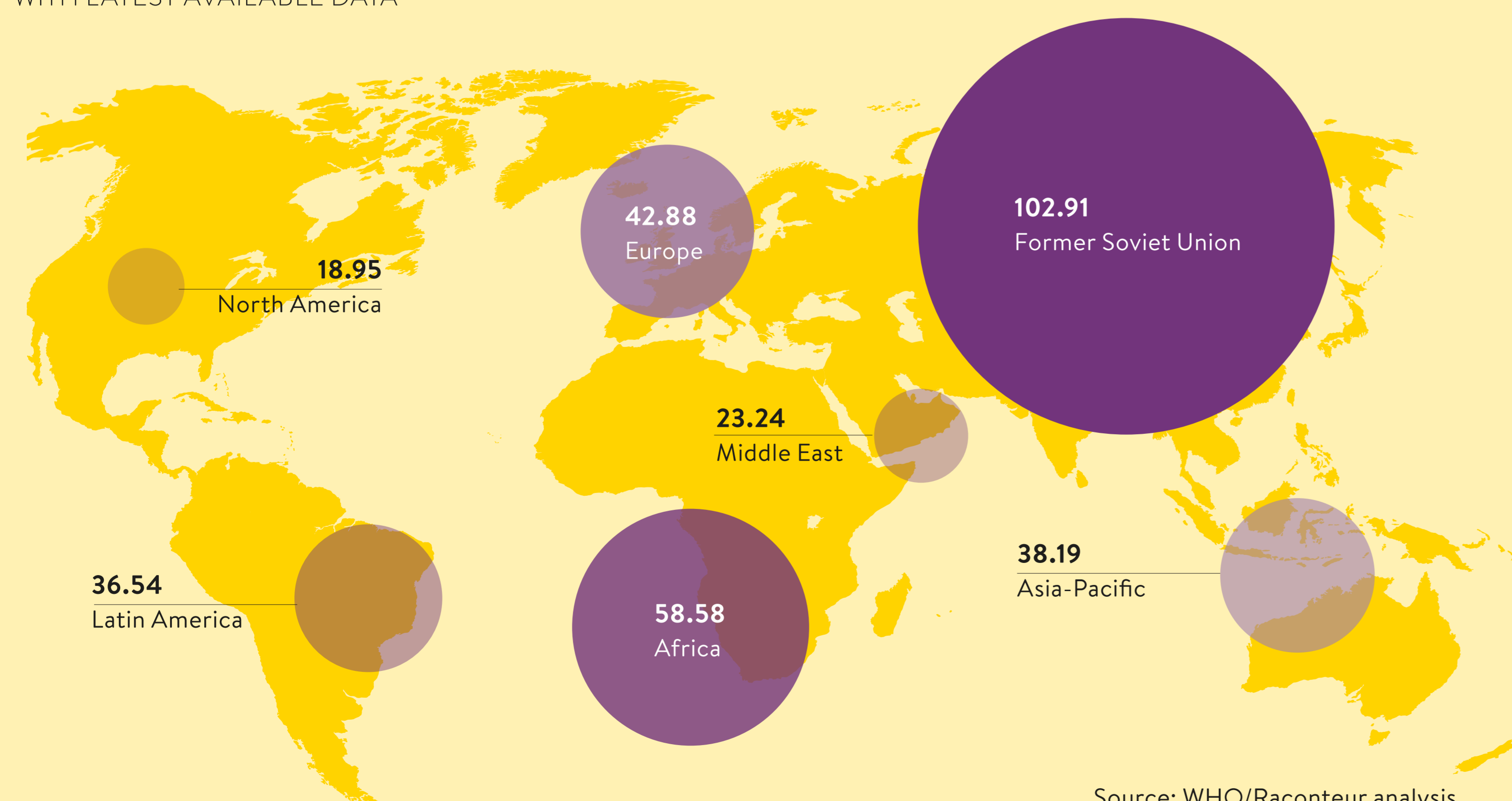
