Ephesians 4:4-7

4 [There is] one body, and **one Spirit**, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling;

5 **One Lord**, one faith, one baptism,

6 One God and Father of all, who [is] above all, and through all, and in you all.

7 But unto every one of us is given grace according to the measure of **the gift of Christ**.

Genesis 2:1-3

Thus the heavens and the earth were finished, and all the host of them.

And on the seventh day God ended his work which he had made; and he rested on the seventh day from all his work which he had made.

And God blessed the seventh day, and sanctified it: because that in it he had rested from all his work which God created and made.

Revelation

14:6 And I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people,

14:7 Saying with a loud voice, Fear God, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters.

Worship To The Creator

John

- 4:23 But the hour cometh, and now is, when the **true worshippers** shall worship the Father in spirit and **in truth**: for the Father **seeketh such** to worship him.
- 4:24 God [is] a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship [him] in spirit and in truth.

Luke

- 4:5 And the devil, taking him up into an high mountain, showed unto him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time.
- 4:6 And the devil said unto him, All this power will I give thee, and the glory of them: for that is delivered unto me; and to whomsoever I will I give it.
- 4:7 If thou therefore wilt worship me, all shall be thine.

Jonah

- 1:5 Then the mariners were afraid, and cried every man unto his god, and cast forth the wares that [were] in the ship into the sea, to lighten [it] of them. But Jonah was gone down into the sides of the ship; and he lay, and was fast asleep.
- 1:6 So the shipmaster came to him, and said unto him, What meanest thou, O sleeper? arise, **call upon thy God**, if so be that God will think upon us, that we perish not.
- 1:7 And they said every one to his fellow, Come, and let us cast lots, that we may know for whose cause this evil [is] upon us. So they cast lots, and the lot fell upon Jonah.
- 1:8 Then said they unto him, Tell us, we pray thee, for whose cause this evil [is] upon us; What [is] thine occupation? and whence comest thou? what [is] thy country? and of what people [art] thou?
- 1:9 And he said unto them, I [am] an Hebrew; and <u>I fear the LORD, the God of heaven, which hath made the sea and the dry [land]</u>.
- 1:10 Then were the men exceedingly afraid, and said unto him, Why hast thou done this? For the men knew that he fled from the presence of the LORD, because he had told them.
- 1:11 Then said they unto him, What shall we do unto thee, that the sea may be calm unto us? for the sea wrought, and was tempestuous.
- 1:12 And he said unto them, Take me up, and cast me forth into the sea; so shall the sea be calm unto you: for I know that for my sake this great tempest [is] upon you.
- 1:13 Nevertheless the men rowed hard to bring [it] to the land; but they could not: for the sea wrought, and was tempestuous against them.
- 1:14 Wherefore they **cried unto the LORD**, and said, We beseech thee, O LORD, we beseech thee, let us not perish for this man's life, and lay not upon us innocent blood: for thou, O LORD, hast done as it pleased thee.
- 1:15 So they took up Jonah, and cast him forth into the sea: and the sea ceased from her raging.
- 1:16 Then the men **feared the LORD** exceedingly, and offered a sacrifice unto the LORD, and made vows.

WHAT CONSTITUTES THE SABBATH

Quote

- The Sabbath was not for Israel merely, but for the world. It had been made known to man in Eden, and, like the other precepts of the Decalogue, it is of imperishable obligation. Of that law of which the fourth commandment forms a part, Christ declares, "Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in nowise pass from the law." So long as the heavens and the earth endure, the Sabbath will continue as a sign of the Creator's power. And when Eden shall bloom on earth again, God's holy rest day will be honored by all beneath the sun. "From one Sabbath to another" the inhabitants of the glorified new earth shall go up "to worship before Me, saith the Lord." Matthew 5:18; Isaiah 66:23. {DA 283.2}
- No other institution which was committed to the Jews tended so fully to distinguish them from surrounding nations as did the Sabbath. God designed that its observance should designate them as His worshipers. It was to be a token of their separation from idolatry, and their connection with the true God. But in order to keep the Sabbath holy, men must themselves be holy. Through faith they must become partakers of the righteousness of Christ.

WHAT CONSTITUTES THE SABBATH

Quote

- When the command was given to Israel,
 "Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it
 holy," the Lord said also to them, "Ye shall
 be holy men unto Me." Exodus 20:8; 22:31.
 Only thus could the Sabbath distinguish
 Israel as the worshipers of God. {DA 283.3}
- As the Jews departed from God, and failed to make the righteousness of Christ their own by faith, the Sabbath lost its significance to them. Satan was seeking to exalt himself and to draw men away from Christ, and he worked to <u>pervert the Sabbath</u>, <u>because it is</u> <u>the sign of the power of Christ.</u>

- 1:18 For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hold the truth in unrighteousness;
- 1:19 Because that which may be known of God is manifest in them; for God hath showed [it] unto them.
- 1:20 For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, [even] his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse:
- 1:21 Because that, when they knew God, they glorified [him] not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened.
- 1:22 Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools,
- 1:23 And changed the glory of the uncorruptible God into an image made like to corruptible man, and to birds, and fourfooted beasts, and creeping things.
- 1:24 Wherefore God also gave them up to uncleanness through the lusts of their own hearts, to dishonour their own bodies between themselves:
- 1:25 Who changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator, who is blessed for ever. Amen.
- 1:26 For this cause God gave them up unto <u>vile affections</u>: for even their women did change the natural use into that which is against nature:

Paul's Sermon to the Romans

Roman 1:27-31

- 1:27 And likewise also **the men**, leaving the <u>natural use</u> of **the woman**, burned in their lust one toward another; <u>men with men</u> working that which is unseemly, and receiving in themselves that recompense of their error which was meet.
- 1:28 And even as they <u>did not like to retain God in [their] knowledge</u>, God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient;
- 1:29 Being filled with all unrighteousness, fornication, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, debate, deceit, malignity; whisperers,
- 1:30 Backbiters, haters of God, despiteful, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents,
- 1:31 Without understanding, covenant breakers, without natural affection, implacable, unmerciful:
- 1:32 Who knowing the judgment of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but have pleasure in them that do them.

The 6th Day Attack Precedes The Close of Probation

Genesis 19:4-10

- 19:4 But before they lay down, the men of the city, [even] the men of Sodom, compassed the house round, both old and young, all the people from every quarter:
- 19:5 And they called unto Lot, and said unto him, Where [are] the men which came in to thee this night? bring them out unto us, that we may know them.
- 19:6 And Lot went out at the door unto them, and shut the door after him,
- 19:7 And said, I pray you, brethren, do not so wickedly.
- 19:8 Behold now, I have <u>two daughters</u> which have not known man; let me, I pray you, bring them out unto you, and do ye to them as [is] good in your eyes: only unto these men do nothing; for therefore came they under the shadow of my roof.
- 19:9 And they said, Stand back. And they said [again], This one [fellow] came in to sojourn, and he will needs be a judge: **now will we deal worse with thee, than with them**. And they pressed sore upon the man, [even] Lot, and came near to break the door.
- 19:10 But the men put forth their hand, and pulled Lot into the house to them, and **shut to the door.**
- 19:11 And they smote the men that [were] at the door of the house with blindness, both small and great: so that **they wearied themselves to find the door**.



ABOMINATION - a thing that causes disgust or loathing. Filthy

- 3:3 Knowing this first, that there shall come in the **last days scoffers**, walking after their own lusts,
- 3:4 And saying, Where is the promise of his coming? for since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as [they were] from the beginning of the creation.
- 3:5 For this they **willingly are ignorant** of, that by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of the water and in the water:
- 3:6 Whereby the world that then was, **being overflowed with** water, perished:
- 3:7 But the heavens and the earth, which are now, by the same word are kept in store, reserved unto fire against the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men.
- 3:8 But, beloved, <u>be not ignorant</u> of this one thing, <u>that one</u> <u>day [is] with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day</u>.

6000 years - 6th Day Attack — Marriage is Attacked before the Sabbath

Quote

• Infidel geologists claim that the world is very much older than the Bible record makes it. They reject the Bible record because of those things which are to them evidences from the earth itself that the world has existed tens of thousands of years. And many who profess to believe the Bible record are at a loss to account for wonderful things which are found in the earth, with the view that creation week was only seven literal days, and that the world is now only about six thousand years old.
