WHAT IS SPARC?


SPARC is a free initial training in which you learn the concepts of cybersecurity. Some courses can be done online, others take place in a city close to you. During these live courses, experts give you and your classmates complex tasks to solve as a group, giving you the opportunity to get to know each other better and work as a team.

The course content is divided in three progressive phases which you complete one after the other. "Scorings" are conducted throughout the program in order to evaluate your knowledge level.

PERSPECTIVES

The SPARC program offers you the opportunity to familiarize yourself with one of the most current issues of our time, and prepares you for the selection into the cyber army. The subsequent Cyber course will enable you to take up an exciting position in the military and open the door to a promising career.

This well appreciated training will be a major asset for your professional future, as Swiss companies are in urgent need of cybersecurity specialists.



In the Explorer phase, you learn the IT basics necessary for the rest of the training as well as for the Cyber course.



This phase allows you to understand the basic problems and concepts of cybersecurity and gives you an overview of the technical competences of defence specialists.



In the Operator phase, you combine the acquired knowledge from the first two phases and deepen it by taking on a specific cybersecurity role.
