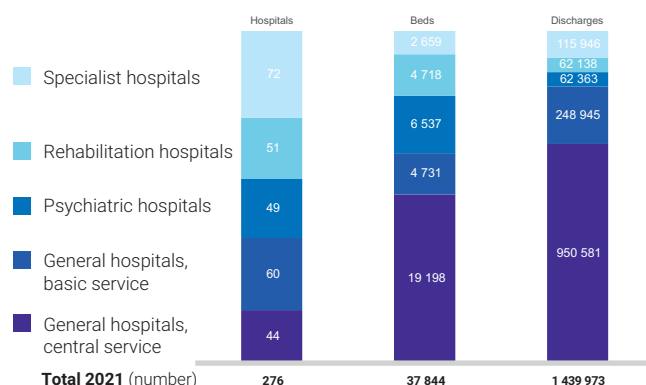

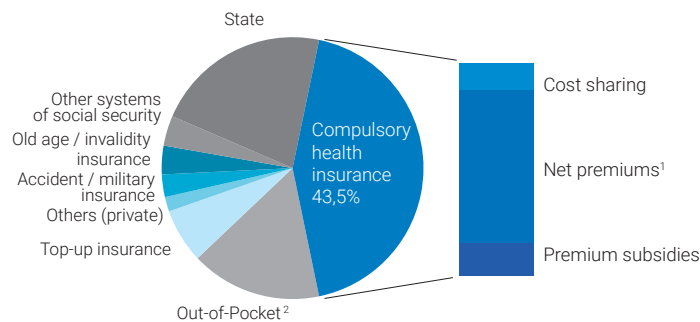

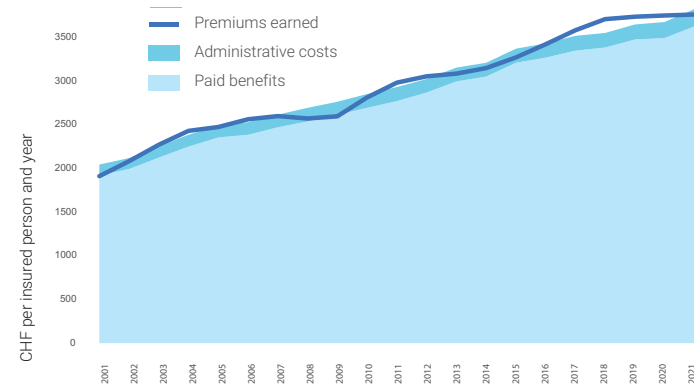

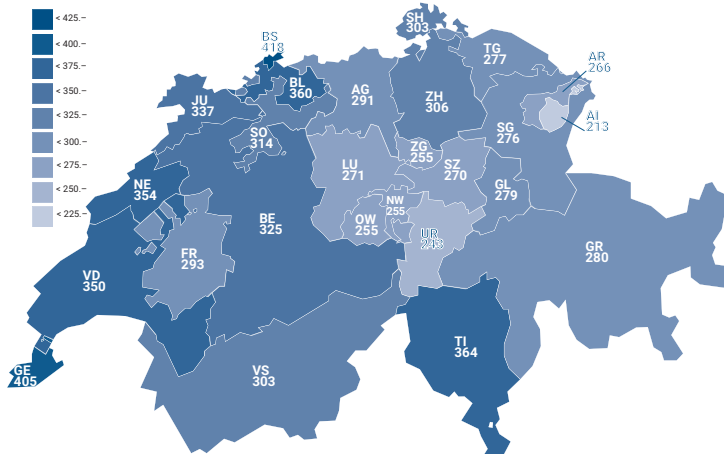

Monthly average cantonal premiums

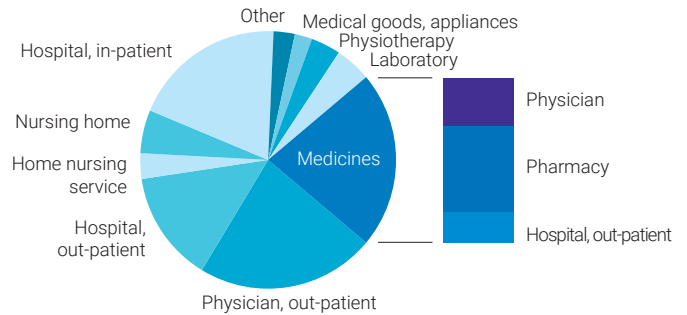
