

Margin Close-Out on MT4

Please note that open positions will be automatically closed if your free equity drops to 50% or below of the required margin level (which will be shown in MT4).

If you fail to deposit additional funds to provide sufficient equity into your account, and/or the markets continue to move against you, you are then at risk of being subject to an automatic close-out of some or all of your open positions. Subject to the underlying market trading hours, priority will be given to the largest losing position(s).

For example, if the current close-out percentage (margin level) is 50% and you have four trades open that each require USD500 worth of position margin, your total position margin requirement will be USD2,000. If the free equity in your account then drops to less than 50% of the total margin requirement, in this case USD1,000, then some or all of the trades constituting this position may be closed out, potentially at a loss to you, until you have returned to above the 50% level.

If you have any open positions, it is your responsibility to ensure that you are aware of our close-out process, as well as to monitor your leverage and margin requirements for all transactions at all times.
