Pruzan was Co-Head of North America FIG M&A from 2008-2009 and was Head of the U.S. Bank Group from 2006-2008. Pruzan was in the Financial Institutions Group at PaineWebber from 1990-1994.

He is also Vice Chairman of the Board of Summer Search New York, serves on the boards of the Peterson Institute for International Economics and the Morgan Stanley Foundation, and is a member of the Economic Club of New York.
