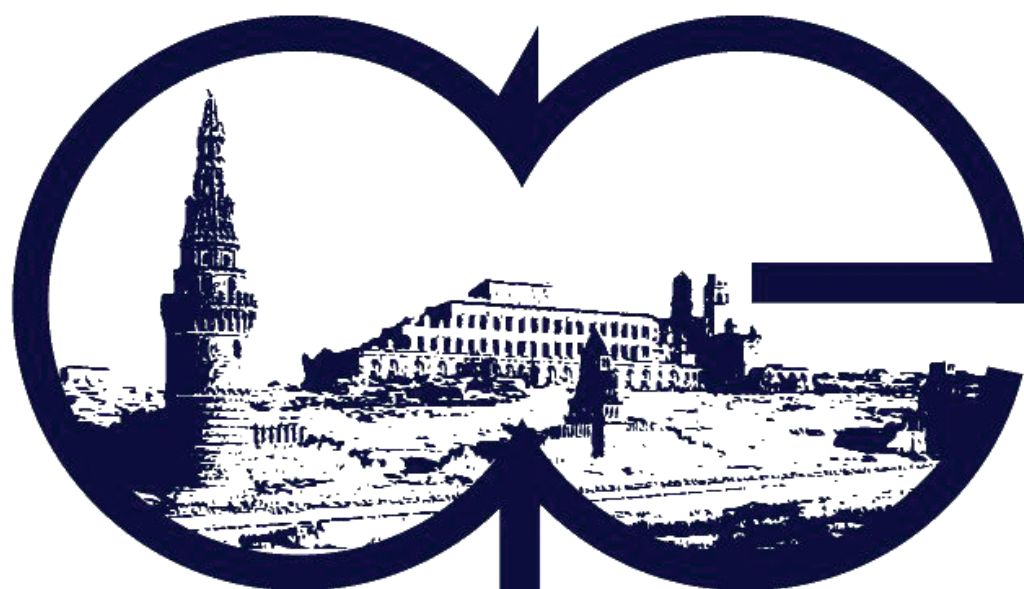

- mutual respect and recognition of the right to self-determination, sovereignty, and independence of each indigenous people and region
- the moderator is not a judge, his task is to help the team to work as productively as possible
- no veto power
- the adoption (a priori) of the norm on the complete and immediate denuclearization of all states without exception of the post-Russian space
