IMPORTANT TIPS FOR SAFE BOATING

The Skipper must keep a copy of C.O.C and C.O.F on the vessel.

Always check that the kill switch works and is connected to your wrist when under way.

Children who are 12 years old or under are required to always wear lifejackets when on a boat.

No person may operate a boat in such a manner that it constitutes a danger to another person or boat.

No person under the age of 16 years may operate a towing vessel.

When towing a skier, the skipper should ensure that there is a competent observer on board to observe the skier and raise the red flag when the skier is in the water

All boats must comply with the rules relating to the no-wake zone and no-go security areas.

Drive anti-clockwise with the shore on your right-hand side.
