Alta Ski Area to Open Friday, November 23rd



Alta Ski Area will open Friday, November 23rd at 9:15am for the 2018-19 season. It's time to dust off the skis as the Collins lift will be spinning, offering up skiing through the Mambo corridor. Mother Nature is expected to deliver a powder feast just in time for the holiday weekend. With snow in the forecast additional terrain will open soon. Ticket prices will be \$81 for adults and \$50 (kids 12 & under) on opening day to celebrate our 81st season. Throughout the winter tickets can be purchased at <a href="mailto:alta.com">alta.com</a> with a savings up to 20% off.

New this season, daily preferred carpool parking at the Wildcat Base for vehicles with three or more persons. Prime parking for lift access will be reserved for carpoolers to reward their support in reducing emissions.

The recently renovated <u>Snowpine Lodge</u> will open on January 30th with 58 luxury guest rooms and 19 dorm rooms. A new addition to the Snowpine Lodge will be Swen's Restaurant and the Gulch Pub featuring a full-service bar. Both are open to the public.

For our skiers, Watson Shelter will be open for food service with Baldy Brews and Watson Café. Goldminer's Daughter Café will open from 7am–5pm daily at the base area. Retail and rental will be available through Alta Ski Shop's Wildcat Base location and the Watson Shelter location.

Alta is proud to keep our Ski at 3 program vibrantly running. Skiers at 3pm can access our beginner lifts from 3–4:30pm daily for \$12.
