- Glass Recycling—We will continue to recycle glass for employees this season. Please place empty glass only (no caps/lids) in bins.


# How You Can Help!

- 1. Determine areas to improve current practices in waste management.
- 2. Increase public transportation and carpooling amongst skiers & employees, by promoting our new <u>Alta Commute Program</u> (https://alta.mycommuteoptions.com/login).
- **3.** Decrease greenhouse gas emissions through an emphasis on improved energy management.

To support our mission and meet our objectives you can do the following:

- Conserve Energy! You can <u>turn off the lights</u> when you leave a room and <u>turn off your computer monitor</u> when it's not in use.
- Carpool or Use the UTA Bus when commuting to Alta.
- Turn Your Key Be Idle Free—Help support your community's campaign in keeping our mountain air clean, plus you will save gas and decrease your carbon footprint.



- 1. Refrain from printing emails
- 2. Purchase a reusable water bottle and travel mug
- 3. Decrease your driving by saving errands for one trip
- **Reuse**—There are many ways to reuse, be creative! Try these tips for starters:
  - 1. Use the travel mug and water bottle you purchased
  - 2. Print and copy on both sides of paper
  - 3. Try purchasing what you need from a 2<sup>nd</sup> hand store first
- **Recycle**—If you can't reduce or reuse first, please recycle! We have blue and green recycle bins throughout Alta Ski Area! Just remember the following:



- 1. Papers that hold liquids are NOT recyclable
- 2. Unscrew caps from bottles
- 3. Know what is recyclable—there are signs to help
- 4. NO dirty napkins or items with food scraps
- 5. Empty all liquids out of containers first
