Alta Ski Area 2021-22 Season Passes Now on Sale



Skiing has looked a bit different this year at Alta Ski Area. Thank you to our skiers, employees and community for helping us complete Alta's 83rd ski season without any interruptions. We are looking ahead to the 2021-22 ski season, with season passes on sale now.

Restoring Alta's Weekend and Holiday Skiing Experience

Mainly unchanged for 83 winters, skiing at Alta still delivers deep snowfall, sweeping mountain views and a laid-back vibe that generations of skiers fondly recall. What has changed is the weekend and holiday skiing experience at Alta. And while we can't go back in time, we are making changes to manage skier demand to preserve the Alta skiing

experience going forward. Implementing a paid parking reservation system on weekends & holidays is a step in that direction.

Why a Parking Reservation System?

We want Alta skiers to know they will have a place to park when they head up the canyon. Additionally, a parking reservation system should ease early morning congestion resulting from limited parking available on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Who

Qualifying Alta passholders will receive code(s) that can be used to book free advance and week-of parking reservations. The passes that are eligible for these reservation benefits include the Alta & Alta-Bird Passes with Benefits: Adult, 65+, 80+, 18-25, Military, Gold Card, Powder Card and 10-Day Cards.

What

Qualifying Alta season passholders will receive weekend & holiday parking reservation benefits. Those include two (2) active advanced reservations and two (2) week-of reservations. Weekend and holiday parking reservations will be available for \$25 per day for all other skiers without Alta pass benefits. Reservation bookings will be available in October 2021, with week-of reservations to be released at least one week before the day.

We ended this year on a high note April 25th with a snowfall total of 487" and powder skiing the last full week we were open. Thank you to everyone who made this year skiable and helped us ski to the end of the season.
