Alta Ski Area 2023–24 Season Passes on Sale



Alta's 85th season will never be forgotten, with 903 inches of snow falling, it was the deepest winter in Alta Ski Area's history. With over 15 feet of snow still blanketing Alta, it's hard to believe the 2023–24 season is only 200 days away. Alta Season Passes went on sale May 1st. Purchase your Alta Season Pass this spring for the best prices of the season.

This past March was the snowiest single month ever recorded at Alta, with 229 inches of snow for the month. Alta also recorded our deepest-ever settled snow depth of 248 inches on April 5th. Alta recorded its first snow on October 22nd and averaged 4.7 inches of snow per day through April 30th. It's fair to say this will be a winter that will be remembered for years to come.

While we can't guarantee another 900-inch winter, we look forward to another great season of family, friends and powder days. Thank you for joining us—in person or in spirit—this season.
