

SHOWER DOME INSTALLATION

EVERYDAY LUXURY



- 1. Please consult all local and state building codes, and read the entire installation instructions prior to beginning the installation of this unit to ensure that the installation is performed correctly.
- 2. Construct a framed pocket that is square and plumb in accordance with rough-in dimensions. When determining the height of the pocket, take into consideration the height of the dome. (See Figure 1)




At this point of the installation, the method used depends upon whether or not there will be access to the back and sides of the unit after it is installed to allow installation of the dome. If there will be access to the back and sides of the unit after installing the unit, METHOD 1 should be used to install a unit with a cap. If there will not be access to the unit after it is installed, METHOD 2 should be used to install the unit.

METHOD 1

- 3. Set the dome aside and install the unit according to its instructions.
- After the unit is installed, place the dome on the unit. From behind the studding, attach the dome using stove bolts. <u>A bead of silicone caulking (not latex caulking) may be placed</u> on the bolt locations and inside the seam between the dome and the unit.
- 5. Attach the side flanges and the top flange of the dome to the studding using screws. (*See Figure 2*) Secure the flanges every 6" or as necessary to keep the flanges flush to the studding.

METHOD 2

- 3. Attach the dome to the unit using stove bolts. <u>A bead of silicone caulking (not latex</u> caulking) may be placed on the bolt locations and inside the seam between the dome and the unit.
- 4. Install the unit per its installation instructions, omitting the step of screwing the horizontal flanges to the studding.
- 5. Attach the side flanges and the top flange of the dome to the studding using screws. (*See Figure 2*) Secure the flanges every 6" or as necessary to keep the flanges flush to the studding.
- 6. You can finish off your new tub with a variety of materials. (tile, drywall, caulking, plaster of paris, wood or plastic trim).
- Clean your new tub with a liquid detergent and warm water. Do not use any abrasive cleaners such as scouring powder, or liquid abrasive cleaners.


