


## Installation Procedure for Swan MOP SERVICE SINK MODEL MS-2424 and MS-2436



**MDDEL** #MS2424-3—24"  $\times$  24" Mop Service Sink with 3" I.P.S. Brass Drain **MODEL** #MS2424-2—24"  $\times$  24" Mop Service Sink with 2" I.P.S. Brass Drain

**MODEL #MS2436-3**—24"  $\times$  36" Mop Service Sink with 3" I.P.S. Brass Drain **MODEL #MS2436-2**—24"  $\times$  36" Mop Service Sink with 2" I.P.S. Brass Drain





## INSTALLATION:

- 1. Read instructions carefully and familiarize yourself with the parts.
- 2. Be certain Mop Service Sink is correct size and in good condition before beginning installation.
- 3. Make sure hole in sub-floor or slab is large enough to accommodate drain and will coincide with the hole in the mop service sink. Hole in sub-floor should be 6" in diameter. Drain pipe should be \%" below sub-floor surface.
- Set drain body into place making sure that screws or drain align with notches on drain opening. Install drain as noted above.
- 5. Place Mop Service Sink into place and level as required. Seal drain with lead and oakum as necessary.
- Seal all edges of Mop Service Sink where wall contact is made.
