

Tile

When properly installed, tile is a durable material that can withstand heavy foot traffic, moisture, and other wear and tear. Unlike Swanstone, tile comes in lots of small pieces that are held together by grout, and waterproofing may be necessary to prevent water from seeping through the seams between the tiles. Tile can be prone to cracking, chipping, or breaking if heavy objects are dropped or if the subfloor is not properly prepared.

Installation • • • • •

The installation of tile can be a complex and time-consuming process, requiring careful handling and precise measurements. The installation is a multi-step process that can take up to 4 days on average for a shower. Surface preparation is required, including installing a cement backer board and ensuring the substrate is level and smooth. The tile must be cut and laid out in a specific pattern, and the grout must be carefully applied, allowed to dry, and then sealed.

The Hassle of Grout Lines • • • • • •

Grout lines can be more challenging to clean and maintain than the tile surface. The porous nature of grout can trap dirt, grime, and bacteria, making it more prone to discoloration and staining over time. In addition, grout lines can be hard to reach, especially in tight spaces or areas with intricate tile patterns. Regular cleaning and maintenance, such as scrubbing with a grout brush and using a sealant to protect the grout from moisture and stains, can help to minimize these issues. Grout in high-traffic and/or wet areas will need resealing every six months to one year.

Inhibits Microbial Growth • • • • •

Due to the high humidity and moisture levels in bathrooms, mildew, mold, bacteria, and other unwanted microorganisms can thrive on the porous surface of the grout. When compared to Swanstone, grout lines between tiles can be more difficult to keep clean and free of bacteria, mainly if the grout is not properly sealed and maintained regularly.

Over time tiles can become damaged or cracked. They must be replaced to prevent water seepage and mold growth; this can be time-consuming and costly. The damaged tiles, as well as the surrounding grout, will need to be removed and replaced. If extra tiles are unavailable from the original installation, matching the existing tile could be a hassle. Additionally, grout can fail or become discolored and may need complete replacement. If the grout shows signs of cracking, it is time to replace it. Removing and replacing old grout is relatively easy, but it is a dirty job and can be tedious.

Sustainable ••••

Porcelain and ceramic tiles are among the few sustainable tile options available, with a low carbon footprint and no dangerous chemicals, plastic, or volatile organic compounds (VOCs). Although they can last a lifetime, the sustainability of tile may be compromised in the long run by potentially harmful silica in some cement-based grout. Exposure to silica particles may be considered a silent contaminant as it contains irritants and allergens that could pose environmental and health risks, potentially harming people and animals.

Anti Slip ●●●○○

Tile can be slippery, particularly when wet. The tile's surface can be smooth and glazed, making it more slippery than a textured solid surface material. However, some tile products have textured or matte finishes, which reduces the risk of slipping. Ultimately, the slipperiness of any material depends on various factors, including surface texture, the presence of water, and the use of additional safety features such as mats or grips.

Less Waste ●●○○○

It is worth noting that there is generally more waste associated with tile than solid surfaces when it comes to cutting and installation. Tile typically requires cutting to fit around corners, edges, and others. Even with precise measuring, it is estimated that as much as 15% of tile is wastage during installation.


Save Time and Money ●○○○○


