la Galerie *du* 19M: creation, innovation, & transmission

A place of work, transmission and conservation of heritage, le19M is the highpoint of a process that began in 1985, when the House of CHANEL bought the first workshops and art factories with which it worked in order to preserve and cultivate their know-how.

le19M is an exceptional piece of architecture whose purpose is to showcase the expertise of craftsmen and designers. It's a unique place that houses workshops, a school and a gallery open to the public.

la Galerie *du* 19M is a modular space that upholds the values of arts and crafts and showcases the emerging creative scene.

Its multi-disciplinary programme is designed with a community of cultural partners and in collaboration with the artisans of the Maisons. It's an invitation to discover expertise, to dream of its creative wealth, to stimulate innovation through the interweaving of artistic disciplines, and to help inspire vocations or stimulate the desire to change careers.

Our programmation – fall 2025 : « *Trouver son monde* »

From September 17 to December 14, 2025, the Galerie du 19M presents *Trouver son monde*, a unique group exhibition bringing together 17 young creators.

In dialogue with the Maisons d'art du 19M, they explore the theme of transmission through a variety of works, including textiles, video, embroidery, and installations. The exhibition is free and open to all, offering a journey where artisanal excellence meets the energy of emerging creativity.

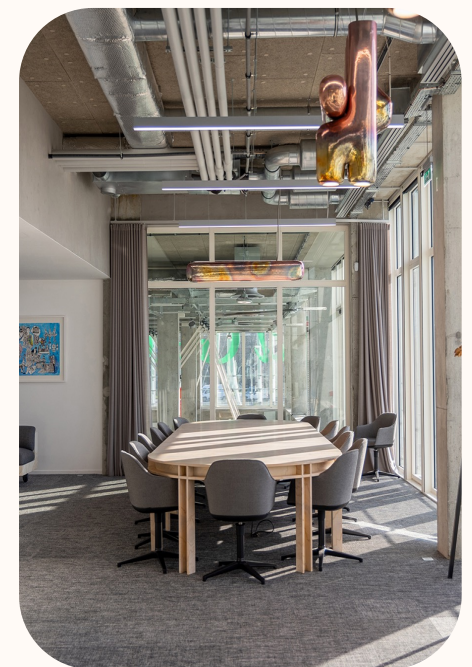

Adjacent to la Galerie du 19M, la Terrasse is set in a 2,600 m² interior garden.

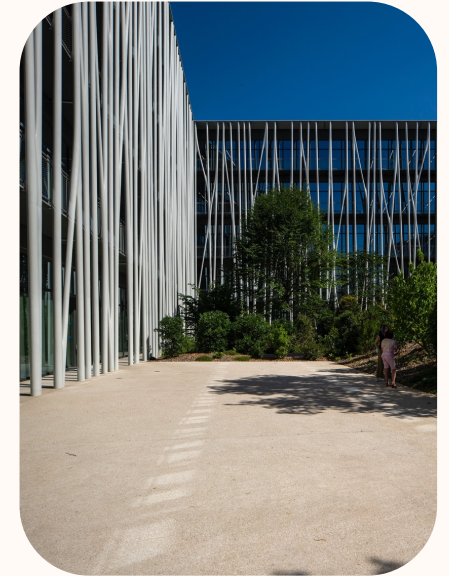

Located on the mezzanine floor of la Galerie, this space is fully soundproofed and equipped.

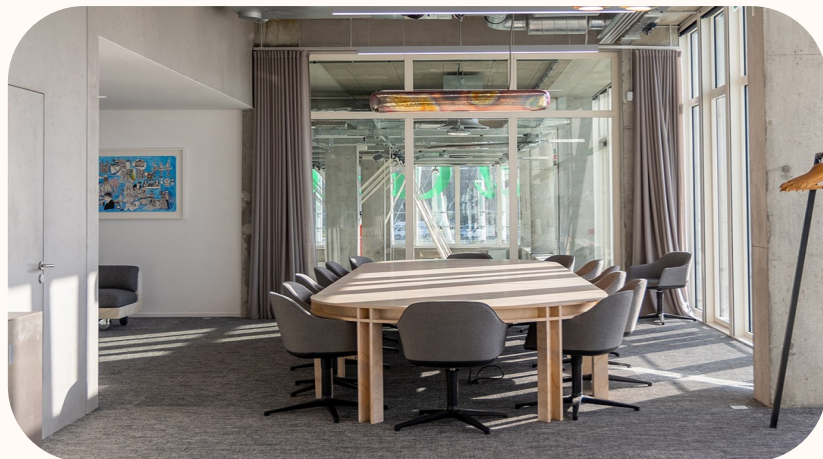
