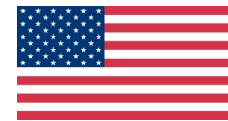

What is TechWomen?

- An annual five-week mentorship and exchange program taking place in San Francisco, Chicago and Washington, DC.
- TechWomen Emerging Leaders develop Impact Projects to be implemented after the program.
- Delegation trips to two TechWomen program countries.
- Managed by the Institute of International Education (IIE), on behalf of the US Department of State's Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs (ECA).

The TechWomen Network

- 1,135 fellows (program alumnae) from 22 countries.
 - Algeria, Cameroon, Egypt, Jordan, Kazakhstan, Kenya, Kyrgyzstan, Lebanon, Libya, Morocco, Nigeria, Pakistan, the Palestinian Territories, Rwanda, Sierra Leone, South Africa, Tajikistan, Tunisia, Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan, Yemen and Zimbabwe
- Over 1,200 volunteer mentors representing 195 companies in Silicon Valley, Chicago and beyond.

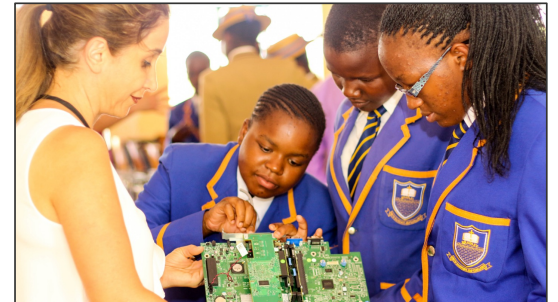
