The municipal elections have begun in Oslo, and your vote might decide who will govern Oslo the coming four years.

Election day is the 10th and 11th of September. However you can vote early from the 10th of August.

Every citizen who is above the age of 18 and has held permanent residency in Norway the last three years are eligible to vote. Norwegian citizenship is not a requirement.

### Achieving more together

### **USE YOUR RIGHT TO VOTE**

There are two elections, the municipal level (bystyre) and the local councils (bydelsutvalg).

Norwegian and Nordic citizens are eligible to vote, as well as people who have lived in Norway permanently at least three years.

You can early vote from the 10th of August until the 8th of September (weekdays between 10am and 7pm, or Saturdays between 10am and 6pm.)

Rememeber to bring an ID with a picture. You do not need to bring an election card.
