

## REPORTING YOUR PLAY FOR PURPOSE EXPENDITURE




Acquittals are the way our fundraising partners account for the funds they raise through the Australian Sports Foundation, including the Play for Purpose raffle program. This is to help ensure that funds raised are being used for the development of sport in Australia, and for a charitable sporting purpose.

We work on a 90-day reporting cycle, however completing your acquittals on the **ASF platform** has never been easier and you can do it at any time before the due date.

For organisations who have received Play for Purpose (P4P) payments, you'll receive regular email reminders to go into the ASF platform and submit an Acquittal. This will simply involve confirming a declaration that you have/will use the grant funds for the approved purpose.


You can view and complete your acquittals in the Programs section of the ASF platform, however the easiest way to see if you have any outstanding reporting to do is by clicking on the **Report My Expenditure** quick link on your Home page.




1. Click on Report My Expenditure beside Play for Purpose details.



2 Your outstanding acquittals will be listed, select one and click on **Declare.** 



3. Read the declaration carefully before clicking **Confirm**.



4. Repeat steps 2-3 for any outstanding acquittals.
