## **Application Format:**

Please provide:

- A cover letter describing why you want to work for Avalanche Canada and why you feel you are the right person for the position.
- A résumé that includes:
  - Full name, mailing address, phone number(s), and email address
  - Citizenship. If non-Canadian, you will be required to prove permanent resident status.
  - Relevant post-secondary education and technical training
    - Include copies of diplomas, certificates, etc.
  - Proof of current membership in relevant professional bodies (e.g. CAA, AGMG, CSGA, CMBGA).
  - A history of professional experience.
  - A list of recent employers with an emphasis on avalanche industry work
  - Contact details for a minimum of two people who can provide references, at least one of whom is an avalanche professional.

#### Application deadline:

Please submit your application by July 10, 2022. Applications received after this date will still be considered if positions remain unfilled.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Avalanche Canada may contact previous employers and references prior to offering an interview.
- Candidates are strongly encouraged to carefully review the Job Description and Qualifications before preparing an application.
