

## WallVIEW Quick-Connect CCU Version 01.03.13

Affects the Quick-Connect CCU component of all WallVIEW CCU products.



### Fixed Issues

The Quick-Connect CCU did not always boot correctly with some cameras. This has been fixed.

## Firmware Update Instructions

You will need:

- A computer with a serial port, or a USB to serial adapter
- Cat-5 cable
- RS-232 Adapter (998-1001-232)

### **Set everything up:**


1. Be sure you know which COM port your computer uses for the serial connection.
2. If you have not done so already, download and install the Vaddio Loader from [support.vaddio.com](http://support.vaddio.com).
3. Download the software update to your computer.
4. Connect your computer's serial port to the RS-232 IN port on the Quick-Connect CCU using the appropriate adapter with the Cat-5 cable.
5. Disconnect the power cable from the Quick-Connect CCU.
6. Disconnect the Cat-5 cable from the RS-232 IN port on the Quick-Connect CCU.

**Start the update:**


1. While holding down the leftmost button, reconnect the power cable to the Quick-Connect CCU. Depending on the model, the button may be labeled CCU Control or Scene A.



2. After booting, the display indicates the CCU is in Firmware Load mode.
3. Reconnect the Cat-5 cable from your computer's serial port to the RS-232 IN port on the Quick-Connect CCU.
4. Open the Vaddio Loader.
5. Select the appropriate COM port if necessary.
6. Select Control as the Product Type.
7. Select your QuickConnect product from the product list.



8. Click Select Load File, browse to the firmware update file that you downloaded, and select it.
9. Check the filename in the box to be sure it's the right one.
10. Click Start. The colored box at the lower right flickers green and red, and the progress bar indicates progress.



Leave the Vaddio Loader open until the firmware finishes loading.
