Firmware Version 5.0.2 - Critical Update

 - Time zone can now be set on the AP
 - Option for the AP to find the XWC-1000 controller if not found during the automatic discovery process
 - Offers limited user interface access to the AP when it is connected to a controller

Known Issues:

- In some web browsers there is no 'spinning wheel' when restoring a config or factory resetting. This may also result in the automatic redirect not being triggered when the reset/restore is finished. If this happens, simply reload the UI.
- Help info for the 3 items in Link Controller not currently available. They are selfexplanatory and will be added in the next release.
