

## LEGRAND UPS NOT FOR SALE IN COLORADO, VERMONT, OR WASHINGTON

United States Department of Energy (DOE) has initiated new energy conservation standards for Uninterruptable Power Supplies (UPS) which take effect on January 10<sup>th</sup>, 2022. The States of Colorado (CO), Vermont (VT) and Washington (WA) have implemented this standard ahead of the effective date for the DOE standards.

The following UPS products currently do not conform to the new DOE standards already adopted by and effective in CO, VT and WA, and therefore cannot be sold into, or offered for sale, lease, or rent in those States.

  - UPS-LL-1500RT
  
- Legrand Online UPS
  - UPS-LO-1000RT
  - UPS-LO-1500RT
