Create Impactwith a Woven Arch

To keep assembly time to a minimum, gather the materials and read through the instructions before beginning.


Materials needed
for a 7'H x 10'W
(2m x 3m)
Air-filled Arch:
Labor: About 45 Minutes
Materials: 64 646Q Giant
Airship Balloons
4 16" (41cm)
Latex Balloons
10 11" (28cm)
Latex Balloons

NOTE:

Larger Arches may require additional support such as monofilament line rigging from above or heavier base weights. Weave a stunning, sturdy Arch with the new 646Q Giant Airship balloons. Because of the width and length of the balloons, this airinflated Woven Arch requires no framework. Ideal for walk-through entrances, it lasts for several days.


Instructions:


Air inflate two 646Q balloons, leaving at least 1" (2.5cm) uninflated on each, and tie the necks together to make a duplet. Make a second duplet in the same manner. Twist two balloons together, one from each duplet, to make a 4-balloon cluster. Lay the cluster down on a flat surface to make an "X." For a spiral pattern, use two different balloon colors as shown.



Make a second cluster like the first and lay it on top of the first cluster, rotating it 45 degrees.

3 Bring two, opposing tips of the first cluster up and tie them together. Repeat with the two remaining tips from the first cluster. Raise the bottom of the second cluster to the middle of the first.







4 Add a third cluster, rotating it 45 degrees, and tie to the top of the first cluster.

Bring the tips of the second cluster up and tie them together as in Step 3.

Repeat to add 13 more clusters.





Make two 5-balloon clusters with the 11" Round balloons inflated to 9" (23cm). Push the clusters between the 646Qs on both ends of the Arch, rotating them at 45-degree angles to the 646Q clusters. Tie in sand or water weights for added stability. To make a water weight, double stuff a 16" balloon and fill with water.


Since most Woven Arches are self-supporting, there's no need to retrieve framework after the event!
