

Instructions for Double-Stuffing Latex Balloons

Use the extensive Qualatex® Rainbow of Colors as a palette from which to create custom colors when you “layer” two different colors. This “double-stuffing” technique creates an unlimited number of unique colors and finishes.

Materials:

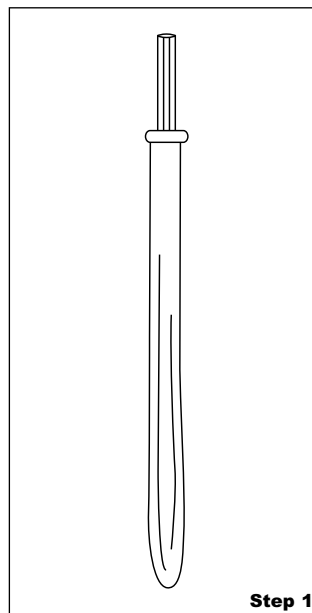
2 Qualatex Latex Balloons of the Same Size
1 Balloon Stick or Straw

Instructions:

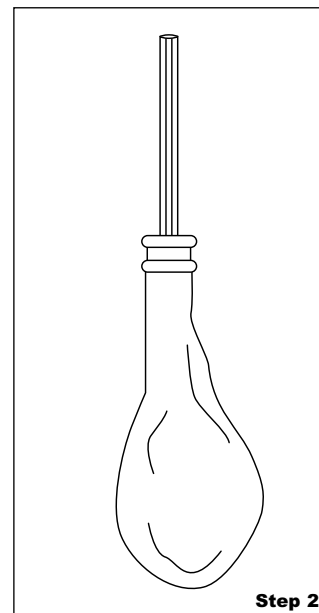
1. Slip an uninflated balloon over a balloon stick or straw, pulling lightly on the balloon to take up the slack. This balloon is the “inner” balloon.
2. Insert the inner balloon into a second, uninflated, “outer” balloon and align the necks.
3. As you inflate the inner balloon, both balloons will expand.
4. To secure, you only need to tie the inner balloon *or* tie the inner balloon around *both* balloon necks.

TIP

Try double-stuffing to create your own unique, customized effects.
