

To whom it may concern:

I would like to voice my dissatisfaction regarding a city employee who demonstrated unprofessional and outright unsafe behavior. The complaint is in reference to the driver of the attached city plow (132874; plate LG990) on 1/28 at 6pm. The driver turned west onto Lombard St where heavy traffic was headed east. He proceeded to stop in the middle of the street and just sit idling. I pulled over the best I could, but he would not pull around me yelling out his window that he didn't want to drive over the "bump" (see snow in the street attached). Instead of plowing said "bump" or himself backing into the intersection from which he had just turned, he yelled out his window "I can sit here all night." I reversed as far as I could but given the line of traffic behind me I had nowhere to go. After sitting for an extended period, the entire line of traffic ultimately had to move in reverse several city blocks and pull onto side streets to allow him space to drive down the middle of the road.
