Notes: Esme is a female patient presenting with severe emaciation. The owner reports that Esme has been living with the owner's brother, who has been staying in a hotel, while Esme remained in a house. The brother occasionally visited to take her out. The owner brought Esme in after discovering her condition. Esme has been neglected and is severely underweight, lacking muscle and fat. She is covered in fecal matter and urine. The owner is seeking care for Esme.

Abdomen:

Notes: Bladder enlarged, non painful abdomen

Rectal: Not performed/severe matting

Body Condition Score: 1/9

Cardiovascular:

Notes: No murmur or arrhythmia, Femoral pulses strong and synchronous

Lymph Nodes:

Notes: All peripheral nodes palpate normally

Musculoskeletal:

Notes: Non ambulatory, severely emaciated with muscle loss. Unable to stand/walk without assistance

Nasal:

Notes: No nasal discharge

Neurologic:

Notes: QAR, generalized weakness , cranial nerves intact, non ambulatory without assistance but able to move limbs

Ophthalmic:

Notes: Clear corneas OU, no discharge OU, normal retina and anterior chamber OU

Notes: mild-moderate dental disease

Notes: Brown waxy discharge AU, severe matting

Reproductive:

Notes: Normal external exam. Spayed.

Notes: Eupneic, no crackles or wheezes ausculted.

Notes: No parasites seen, severe matting barely able to see down to skin. Feces and urine embedded into coat with severe odor, especially around rear end.

Notes: Urine soaked skin, bladder enlarged but soft
