Client Communication:

O called to schedule appointment for splint removal-severely overdue and O was notified to come in immediately for removal. On triage evaluation notified O that radiographs recommended to assess for healing, O had cost concerns and approved radiographs but declined radiograph review. Administered butorphanol IM as above to facilitate and performed radiographs. Updated O re: concerns for healing. Recommended referral to orthopedic specialist. Emailed O list of orthopedic specialists. Discussed surgical repair likely ~8k but would need to get estimate from specialist. Discussed amputation. Told O we could get more accurate estimate for amputation here but suspect about 4-6k. Gave O information on Spay Now. O not ready to move forward with amputation. O elected for continued splinting and rechecking in 1 week. Discussed importance of appropriate splint care and rest. Also discussed concerns for skin lesions from splint being left in place-clipped and cleaned and sedated as above and replaced splint. Owner to recheck in 1 week if unable to pursue orthopedic consult, likely will need to reconsider amputation. Discussed concerns for comfort without appropriate treatment of leg. Emailed O discharge instructions.

Prognosis: Poor for leg and comfort

Dear Latreese,

These are the discharge instructions for Spade.

Diagnosis/Problem List

Fracture (bone break)-poor healing

Discussion

Spade presented to Eastern Animal Hospital for removal and recheck of his broken leg. The splint was left on for too long and there was skin irritation/infection. X-rays also revealed poor union (poor healing) of the bones. I recommended consultation with an orthopedic specialist and emailed a list of specialists. Unfortunately if Spade is not healing and orthopedic consultation/surgery is not an option than amputation may be the best option. If bones do not heal well they can be chronically painful.

You elected to have Spade sedated and have the splint replaced today. Splints/casts usually stay on for 4-6 weeks and are changed after the first week and then every 1-2 weeks thereafter. If the splint/cast becomes dirty, wet, or slips it needs to be changed immediately. Even the best applied splints can slip and rechecks are required for each reapplication. Depending on a pet's comfort, they will often need sedation or pre-visit medications to facilitate splint/cast changes. Your pet will also need to be STRICTLY rested. Any running, jumping, or playing increases the risks of splint complications and poor healing. Please be aware that there are charges for the rechecks, splinting/casting, medications, and X-rays.

Trazodone can also be given as needed for mild sedation and to help with resting Spade.

Please give pain medications as directed unless otherwise advised by veterinary staff. Even if a veterinary patient appears comfortable, pets do not always display outward signs of pain and fractures are very painful. Please seek veterinary attention if you are concerned about any side effects.

Home Care

Diet

They may be fed their normal diet. Please fast them after 8pm the night prior to vet visits in case sedation is necessary for follow up visits.

Activity

Please keep your pet STRICTLY rested, we recommend keeping them kenneled / in a crate whenever possible. Please contact us if you are having trouble keeping Spade rested.

Splint Care

The splint/bandage must be kept clean and dry at all times. If at any point it becomes wet or soiled, please call us immediately to schedule a change.

An e-collar should be worn at all times to prevent Spade from chewing on the coaptation device (bandage, splint, cast).

Recommendations and Follow Up

Please schedule a recheck with your primary care Veterinarian in 1 week if they are doing well, please follow up sooner if you have any splint/ cast complications or overall concerns. If you elect for amputation please contact us or Spay Now.

Please note that medication refills may take up to 48 hours.

SWO, discussed sedation for bandage change. Discussed plan of another bandage change in 1 week and recheck x-rays in 2 weeks. From there, may be able to downgrade to just a soft padded bandage for 2 weeks to allow more pressure on the fracture to promote healing. Owner approved estimate for sedation and bandage change. The bandage had mild urine soaked through at the distal most aspect. The leg was stable with no crepitus on gentle palpation. No bandage sores identified. Reiterated importance of activity restriction to promote healing. Rx for Trazodone prescribed.
