On Sunday 6/7/26 On-call ACO Forgrave(215) received a call from the Emergency Animal Hospital of Ellicott City. A woman abandoned a N/M white w/blk Pitbull in their office. The dog had bite wounds all over his face and body. The woman left without providing any information. The vet provided the car tag number as #4GP1702, a black mustang. Dog has Microchip#981020027326629 but the vet did not trace the microchip. The Vet asked that the dog be picked up asap explaining he would not stop barking and was disturbing/causing stress to the cats in the clinic. They stated the dog was in stable condition and could wait until following day for treatment at the shelter contracted veterinarian. The vet gave the dog 600mg of Gaba. and 100mg of Traz. at 4:20pm to relieve suspected stress & anxiety causing the consistent barking. 215 transported the dog to shelter and cleaned/used a warm compress on the injuries. 215 wrote a vet transport for the dog to go to Glenwood the following day. 215 looked up the Microchip in the universal database online and found it was a Petlink microchip that had been updated that day but the owner wasn't listed and the company would need to be contacted. 215 checked HCAC's microchip database and did not find the chip. 215 will look up the vehicle tag information on Monday.

On Monday 6/8/26 215 traced the license plate number in Meters to Alexa Dumpe 3219 Taylor Avenue Apt 2, Parkville MD 21234. 215 searched for the name on Facebook and found pictures on Ms. Dumpe's page of her with the same dog. The microchip was traced by HCAC staff to owner Alexa Dumpe at 3301 Gilford Ave in Baltimore, MD. The microchip implantation sight was MD SPCA. 215 called and left a voicemail for Ms. Dumpe to call back.

On Tuesday 6/9/26 the hospital manager Matt McDonald at the Emergency Animal Hospital of Ellicott City emailed a surveillance video of a woman believed to be the owner abandoning the dog in the lobby of their office. The video shows the woman speaking to the receptionist. She tells the receptionist she found the dog tied up at a gas station nearby. The receptionist scans the dog for a microchip and finds the dog is microchipped. The receptionist begins to attempt to trace the chip to identify an owner. The receptionist attempts to hand the leash back to the woman, the woman initially refuses to take the dog's leash but eventually loops the leash to a chair. She explains she found the dog and was attempting to do the right thing by bringing it to the vet office but it was not her dog. She believes the dog needs medical treatment and points out there is blood visible on him and he is injured. The receptionist advises her to contact Animal Control or take the dog to them the following day but she cannot leave the dog at their office. The woman insists they hold the dog in a cage while they trace the chip. Staff comes to the receptionist area for the dog and the woman says that she is leaving and walks out the door. An employee follows the woman outside but the woman did not return with the employee.

On 6/11/26 215 had not received a response from Ms. Dumpe. 215 provided the information to Baltimore City Animal Control inquiring if they would follow-up on the matter.

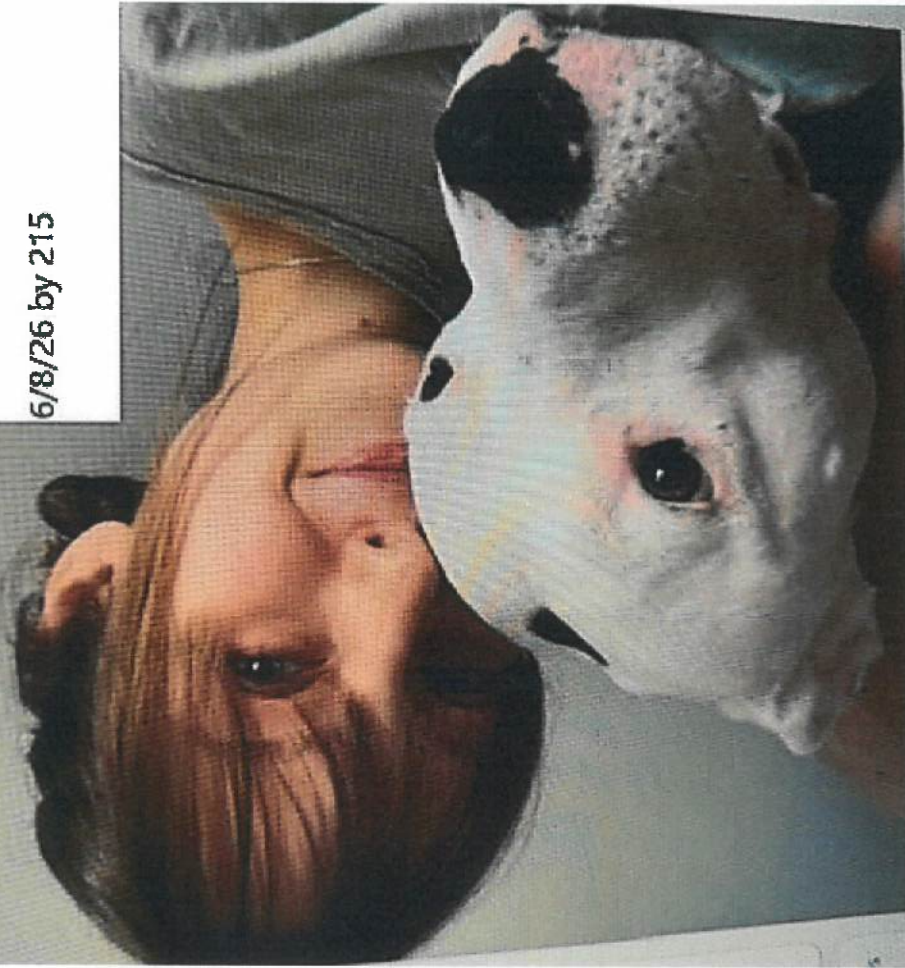
