Failure to provide a completed Replacement Request form within five (5) business days will result in the closure of your service request.

Please note: Trash cans and recycling carts belong to the City of Baltimore and are associated with a specific address. Both cans and carts are to remain at the assigned address, even if the homeowner moves.
