If the can or cart assigned to your household is missing, lost, or stolen, please complete and return this form within five (5) business days of receipt to dpw.trashcans@baltimorecity.gov or mail to Baltimore City Department of Public Works, Attn: Municipal Trash Can Program, 3311 Eastbourne Ave, Baltimore, MD, 21224. Failure to provide a completed Replacement Request form within five (5) business days will result in the closure of your service request.

Please note: Trash cans and recycling carts belong to the City of Baltimore and are associated with a specific address. Both cans and carts are to remain at the assigned address, even if the homeowner moves.
