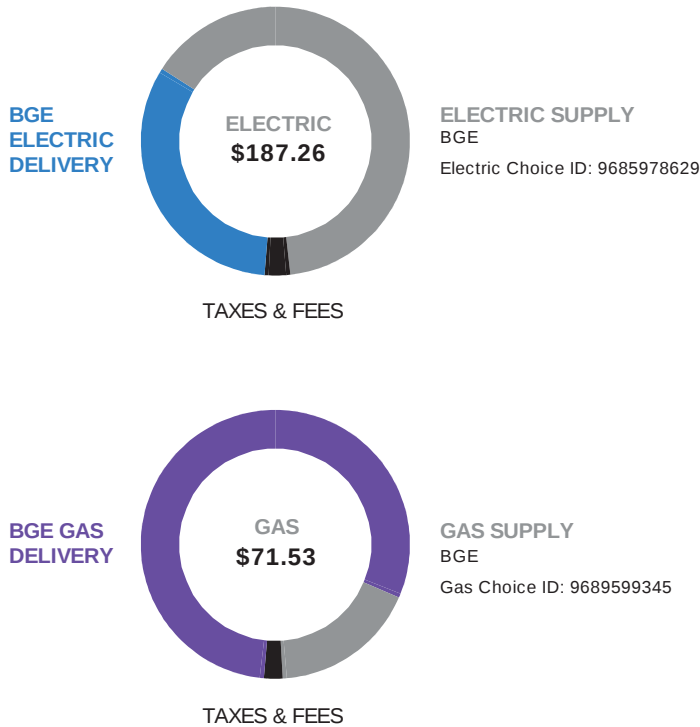

BGE Supply Price Comparison Information: The current price for Standard Offer Service (SOS) electricity is 14.609 cents/kWh, effective through September 30, 2026. SOS electricity will cost 15.223 cents/kWh beginning October 1, 2026 through May 31, 2027. The weighted average price of SOS electricity will be 15.005 through May 31, 2027. The price for SOS from June 1, 2027 through September 30, 2027 will be set in November 2026.

Blackout Risk

Why your electric bill is going up ↗

The biggest part of your bill is the cost of PJM Supply which is generated by private power plant owners like Calpine, NRG, Talen Energy, Vistra and Constellation.

Customers are seeing the impact of multiple forces at once. These factors together are driving upward pressure on bills.

PJM Supply costs

A charge for the electricity provided to you during the billing period. BGE does not control or profit from PJM Supply costs.

Delivery costs

The cost of wires, poles and equipment that deliver electricity safely and reliably to your home or business.

Fees

State and local taxes, fees, and credits including EmPOWER Maryland charges that fund energy-efficiency programs that are paid directly to the state or support state programs.
