

What to Expect for Your Child's Day of Surgery

To Do List:

Between Now & the Surgery	
	Call 904-202-2280 within two weeks before surgery to pre-register
	Biological or Adopted parent must be present for child's surgery. If your child is accompanied by anyone other than the guardian, proof of legal guardianship must be presented prior to surgery. Surgery may be cancelled if the court paperwork has not been provided and approved in advance.
	If your child should become ill within one week of surgery, please notify your child's surgeon.
	If your child is on any medications, please discuss with one of our nurses at 904-202-8265 , to determine which medications should/should not be given prior to surgery. A nurse may call you in advance to discuss your child's medical history.
The Day Before Surgery	
<u>P</u>	lease refer to this sheet when the nurse calls you the day before and fill in the blanks below
	A Wolfson nurse will call you after 2 pm on the day before (or on Friday for a Monday surgery) your child's surgery to confirm your time for arrival and eating and drinking instructions.
Food/Drink Instructions: ALL solids / cereal / milk / formula / thickeners / candy, gum, mints MUST STOP at 11:30pm the day before. Breastmilk MUST STOP 6 hours prior to surgery time. Stop breastmilk at:	
Cle	ear liquids until: four hours before surgery.
	To help prevent infection, please give your child a bath with antibacterial soap (such as Dial) the night before and the morning of surgery. Sometimes we will give special wipes to wash with on the morning of surgery.

	Please remove the following before coming: Earrings, jewelry, other piercings, hair ties with metal, contact lenses, nail polish, and retainers.
	Females who have had their first period will be asked to provide a urine sample upon arrival.
