The Child Feeding Questionnaire

A great online resource from <u>Feeding Matters</u> is available to help you monitor your child's feeding skills as their diet progresses. The <u>Infant and Child Feeding Questionnaire</u> helps parents identify areas of strengths, as well as areas of concerns.

It reviews your child's feeding behaviors, and at the end of the questionnaire, you will receive a report that can help guide discussions with your child's physician and help you express any concerns.
