

COVID-19 Testing for Pediatric Surgical and Procedural Patients

Wolfson Children's Hospital is committed to keeping all patients, physicians, team members and visitors safe. That's why all patients are now required to be tested for COVID-19 prior to any surgery or procedure — even if a patient has no symptoms or reason to believe they may be COVID-positive. Please keep the following in mind as you prepare for surgery:

- Patients must complete a COVID-19 test **4 days prior** to their scheduled procedure, in accordance with the following chart:

Surgery Day	Testing Day
Sunday	Wednesday prior to surgery
Monday	Thursday prior to surgery
Tuesday	Friday prior to surgery
Wednesday	Saturday prior to surgery
Thursday	Sunday prior to surgery
Friday	Monday prior to surgery
Saturday	Tuesday prior to surgery

- A physician order is required to perform a COVID-19 test
- After completing the COVID-19 screening, patients should self-isolate until the day of their surgery or procedure to prevent exposure
- Positive results will be called to the ordering physician, and the surgery or procedure will be canceled
- On the day of surgery, patients will be screened for fever and COVID-19 symptoms prior to entry into the building
- One visitor will be permitted to accompany the patient on the day of the surgery or procedure
- All patients and visitors will be required to wear a mask or face covering in accordance with CDC recommendations and Wolfson Children's Hospital's masking policy
