Application Checklist and Screening Criteria Clinical Pastoral Education

The following criteria are used as guidelines to screen applicants for possible participation in an interview for: Chaplain Intern/Resident/Certified Educator Training positions:

A. Requirements for admission to our Level I/II CPE program include but are not limited to the following:

- ✓ A completed ACPE application.
- ✓ An admission interview, to determine readiness for clinical learning, with a committee made of one or more of the following: an ACPE Certified Educator, a Certified Educator Candidate, a Senior Chaplain, and/or a Staff Chaplain.
- ✓ Either graduation from high school/completion of a GED or ordination by a religious/spiritual tradition or commission to function in spiritual care by an appropriate religious spiritual authority as determined by ACPE.
- ✓ Fulfillment of some or all of education/experience listed below.
- ✓ A signed Use of Clinical Materials Consent Form: https://cdn.manula.com/user/4287/docs/consent-form v1.docx

B. Criteria used as guidelines to screen applicants for a possible interview for positions as a Chaplain Intern/Resident are as follows:

All application levels contain evidence of the following:

- ✓ Current faith group connection
- ✓ Ordination by faith community or commission to function in ministry by an appropriate religious authority as determined by ACPE (<u>www.acpe.edu</u>).
- ✓ Graduation from High School /completion of G.E.D.
- ✓ B.S. or B.A. degree from institution accredited/recognized by Council for Higher Education Accreditation (www.chea.org).
- ✓ Ability to conceptualize a pastoral care perspective with an openness to developing a responsive ministry.
- √ 1 year of seminary or life experience equivalencies
- ✓ Previous pastoral care experience.
- ✓ Application fee of \$25.00 (non-refundable).

Additional items required for Resident Applicants:

- ✓ M.Div. degree from institution accredited/recognized by (www.chea.org).
- ✓ All final evaluations from applicant's prior units of CPE, both from their ACPE Certified Educators and self-evaluations.
- ✓ Sample Verbatim

^{**}Due to VISA stipulations, all international residents must apply four months prior to applications being due.

- C. Requirements for admission to our Certified Educator Candidate program include but are not limited to the following:
 - ✓ A completed Application for Certified Educator Programs
 - ✓ College graduation
 - ✓ Graduate theological degree or its equivalent
 - ✓ Ordination or commissioning to function as a spiritual care provider by an appropriate religious/spiritual authority as determined by ACPE
 - ✓ Endorsement/statement of accountability from an appropriate religious/spiritual authority as determined by ACPE
 - ✓ Successful completion of a minimum of four units of Level I/Level II CPE
 - ✓ Demonstration of spiritual care and conceptual competence as evidenced by the attainment/completion of Level I/Level II Outcomes
 - ✓ Evaluation of the competencies for admission to a Certified Educator Program

Additional items required for Certified Educator Candidate Applicants:

- ✓ Completion of 2 or more Level II CPE Units
- ✓ Current ACPE Clinical Membership
- ✓ APC Board Certified or in-process of submitting application
- √ 2-3 years pastoral experience
- ✓ Paper summarizing motivation for supervisory education (1-2 pages)
- ✓ Passing of the admission interviews by Baptist Health CPE Faculty and ACPE Admission Committee.
- D. All applications will be additionally evaluated on the following criteria, no matter the format of the submission:
 - ✓ Organization, clarity, and grammar.
 - ✓ Thorough response to application questions/topics.
 - ✓ Transparency of feelings and reflection upon significant life events and relationships.
 - ✓ Inclusion of personal and professional strengths and limitations.
 - ✓ Openness to persons from diverse faith, cultural, and socioeconomic backgrounds.
 - ✓ Motivation to learn about self and pastoral care.
