## How can I qualify for a free mammogram?

To qualify for an appointment, you must:

- Live in the greater Jacksonville area, including Duval County as well as Clay, Nassau, Baker and St. Johns Counties
- Be uninsured
- Be 40 or older
- Have a primary care physician who can write a physician's order

## What steps should I take to schedule a free mammogram?

1. Schedule an appointment with a clinic listed above or your primary care physician to get a physician's order for a screening mammogram.
2. The clinic or your physician will send your screening order to Baptist Health and help you set up an appointment.
