
All Trimmed sizes will match East and West.

Due to the organic design, some panels from group A will need to be trimmed North & South to match on the top and bottom (see table above).




### Cumulus Top & Bottom Cut Dimensions

Ensure Panel is facing the right way, prior to trimming




### Linked Top & Bottom Cut Dimensions



### Molecular Top & Bottom Cut Dimensions





#### STEP 1

Be certain that your substrate will hold an adequate bond to the recommended adhesive(s). If in doubt about a coating or a finish already in place, an adhesion mock up test is recommended before you begin.

Cut, scribe and dry pre-fit all Zintra panels as necessary.





Once all of the panels have been properly sized and trimmed, begin applying the adhesive to the BACK SIDE (ONLY) of each panel. Follow suppliers instructions carefully to ensure a consistent and secure fix.


First apply a bead around the entire perimeter of the BACK of the panel.Place the bead to be no more than 20 mm in from the perimeter at any point.

Next, apply a zig zag or diagonal pattern of additional adhesive across the central sections of the panel, within the perimeter bead. See images on the right for guidance.


#### STEP 3

Apply the panel to the substrate within 20 minutes and monitor your adhesive to prevent it from skinning over. Set the panels into place and smooth with open palms.

Now, remove the panel from the substrate and hold it off the surface for one minute. Then reset the panel into place and smooth with firm pressure to set it. Use mechanical fasteners if you see the need to help this stay positioned while the adhesive remains wet.

Never use solvent based contact adhesives. Baresque highly recommend testing any glue prior to a full wall install.

Do not reverse or flip panels.







#### STEP 4

If you have wall GPO's, windows and doors in the way of your panels - ensure you do not install the panels until you have measured the protruding objects.

#### Notes:

Dry fit panels after cutting, to ensure correct fit prior to glueing to substrate.

Continuously go over cutline to create clean and tidy cut.



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#### **OPTION 1**

Install the first panel within the centre of the wall and then install one panel on each side. This means you will will have to trim both panel 4 & 5. This ensure the line of sight is directly in the middle of the wall.



#### **OPTION 2**

Install the first panel on either the left or right side and work your way across. This means you only have to trim one panel.
