Meet Fr. Jim Kubicki, SJ

Fr. Jim Kubicki was born and raised in Milwaukee, Wl. He entered the Society of Jesus in 1971 and was ordained in 1983. He served as Vocation Director and Director of Formation for the Wisconsin Province. He worked at the Sioux Spiritual Center for Native Americans in South Dakota. He has given

preached retreats since 1986 and was on staff at Demontreville, the Jesuit retreat house in Lake Elmo, MN. In 2003 he became National Director of the Pope's Worldwide Prayer Network (Apostleship of Prayer), a position he held for 14 years. In 2017 he moved to the Rosebud Reservation in South Dakota, where he currently serves as Director of St. Francis Mission. Fr. Kubicki appears regularly on Catholic radio shows. His book *A Heart on Fire: Rediscovering Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus* was selected by Catholic Book Publishers Association as among the three best spirituality books in 2012. His latest book is *A Year of Daily Offerings*.
