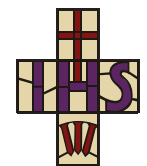

## Ignatian Spirituality for Adults & Youth

### Meet Darius Villalobos, Youth Minister & Kairos Leader



Darius Villalobos is on a mission. As the Director of Diversity and Inclusion for the National Federation of Catholic Youth Ministry, the 34-year-old is leveraging his commitment to serve diverse communities and young people. His goal: to help the Catholic Church become a more welcoming and inclusive community for all.

Darius attributes the joy he has today to many years of discernment and a willingness to place his life in God's hands. These are lessons he discovered on retreats at Bellarmine Jesuit Retreat House beginning in high school.

"I will never forget my first Kairos retreat in high school," says Darius, who went to Lane Technical College Preparatory High School and attended St. Mark Parish in Humboldt Park. "My grandpa, aunts, and uncles were all in ministry, so I grew up in church circles. But I never took that seriously as a vocation for myself. On that first retreat I started watching the retreat leaders and how they were interacting with us and it seemed so fun and fulfilling. I remember

thinking, 'Is this what people really do for a living?'"

Despite his admiration for the retreat leaders and their work, Darius had other ambitions. "I wanted to be a writer and an editor and was planning my life around my career," he says about his years in college at DePaul. At the same time, he volunteered with the parish youth ministry program. "I kept feeling this nagging pull."

That's when he was re-introduced to the North Side Kairos program that made it possible for him to attend a retreat at Bellarmine as a public school student. A collaborative, diversity-based effort by Chicago parishes, North Side Kairos brings together youth from around Chicago who otherwise would miss out on an experience offered to many of their Catholic school peers.

"I'll never forget the impact Bellarmine had on me," says Darius. "Here I was, this kid who grew up in the city, and we take this school bus away from all the concrete and grayness and suddenly everything is green and we're right in the middle of this beautiful nature. It was amazing."

"On the silent retreats, I learned that it is really important to listen to God," he says. "How can you do that if you are doing all the talking and filling the air with noise? When you go into silence, you are creating space for God to talk to you."

As a volunteer for North Side Kairos, Darius continues

to take young people back to Bellarmine with the hope that they will find the transformation and discernment he found.

"I tell them that it's important to get away if for no other purpose than to think about and work on their relationship with God," he says. "Retreats are such a good way to re-calibrate yourself and to get in touch with the feelings and emotions that are right below the surface."

"When I think of my own Kairos experience in high school, a ministry profession seemed so far away from what I imagined I'd ever be doing," says Villalobos. "But I now realize that God planted the seed in me way back then. I just needed to learn how to trust and to say yes. I now realize that God's plan for me was so much more exciting than anything I was planning." ✠

## Service to the Poor

Before our renovation project began this spring, we contemplated what to do with the furniture we would be replacing. Bellarmine Buildings & Grounds Supervisor, Pat O'Hagan, made sure none of the furniture and materials would go to waste. We recycled 12,500 pounds of steel to do our part in caring for the environment. Read below to find out where these gently used items from the manor home landed.

### Habitat for Humanity, McHenry ([www.chicagolandhabitat.org](http://www.chicagolandhabitat.org))

In February, Habitat for Humanity picked up:

- 20 chairs
- 2 tables
- 1 dresser
- 1 nightstand
- 2 track lights
- 2 doors
- 250 light bulbs

### Chicago Furniture Bank ([www.chicagofurniturebank.org](http://www.chicagofurniturebank.org))

In August, the Chicago Furniture Bank, which supplies furnishings to low-income families in the Chicagoland area, picked up the remaining items from the manor home retreat rooms:

- 30 bed frames
- 30 mattresses
- 30 box springs

In April, our retreat house was closed to staff due to the stay-at-home order. All the dry food in our kitchen pantry was donated to Catholic Charities just as they were experiencing a food shortage due to COVID-19.

In June, we discovered that Shepherd's College for students with intellectual disabilities was in need of furnishings for 25 new dorm rooms. It just so happened that we were clearing out furniture from 26 retreat rooms! We donated:

- 26 dressers
- 26 table lamps
- 26 nightstands
- 50 chairs

## Prayer

### Meet Gene Croisant, Board Member & Retreatant

When Gene Croisant was a junior at Loyola University, his best friend invited him on a silent retreat at Bellarmine. He was initially skeptical and had no expectations. It certainly never crossed his mind that the weekend could change his life. "I thought I would go crazy from the quiet," says Gene. Now, he is grateful that he reluctantly told his buddy, "Okay, I'll try it."

Since 1957, Gene has attended 58 retreats at Bellarmine and served on the Board of Directors for 15 years. "It has become a very important part of my life," he says. "Somehow I found God and His role in my life. I found the retreat exceptionally valuable. I've continued to love Ignatian spirituality and the Jesuits my whole life." A year after graduation, Gene became Catholic.

For the next six decades, Gene forged a brilliant career in banking. But it is not in this success that Gene sees his legacy. Early in his career, he started finding his true purpose on the sidelines of the business world. "The Jesuits have inspired me to ask how I can best use my talents," he says. "The retreats gave me a sense of mission that it's not about the business, but your spiritual life. It is my responsibility to contribute to the well-being of others and, ultimately, society. For me, it means working to support Jesuit organizations and Bellarmine to create education and retreat experiences for others."

A former Infantry Captain with the US Army, Gene

was instrumental in launching Bellarmine's "Coming Home" retreats. The retreats have helped military men and women just like him reflect on the transitions to and from military life and find deeper meaning.

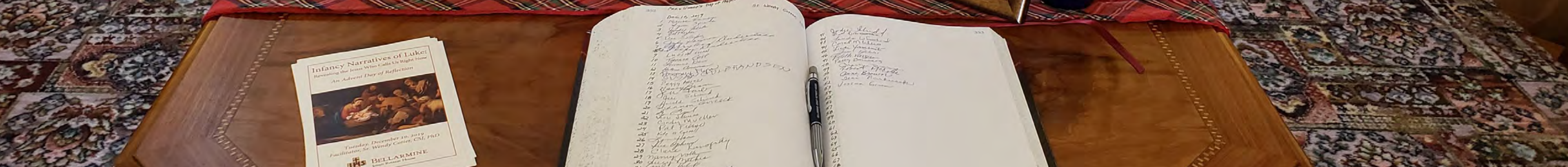


Gene and his wife, Barbara

Almost 20 years ago, Gene's wife of 55 years, Barbara, was diagnosed with colon cancer that had metastasized to her liver. They turned to Bellarmine and prayer throughout their emotional journey. Fr. John Dillon, SJ, who served as Bellarmine's Director from 1999 – 2006, remembered the couple every day in prayer. Barbara has been cancer free for 19 years. "It was truly a miracle," says Gene. "There is no question that she was healed as a result of prayer."

These days, the couple volunteers to support other patients at Mayo Clinic Hospital in Phoenix. Gene brings his Wheaten Terrier to the chemotherapy clinic to comfort the 40 or so patients. "Many people tell me about the kind of dog they had as a kid or something about their childhood and school they went to. When the conversation takes a turn, I ask if it is okay if I can pray for them in my nightly prayers with my wife that evening. I've learned that we can get through anything with prayer, that we have to rely on the Holy Spirit." ✠

### Meet Maureen Kennedy Barney, Retreatant & Ignatian Volunteer

As the oldest of six in an Irish Catholic family on the East Coast, Maureen Kennedy Barney's faith has influenced her life since the day she was baptized. How God cares for us and how we are called to care for others are themes that inspired Maureen's personal and professional life for the next six decades.

She graduated from Boston College, directed admissions for Seton Hall University, married her husband, Dan, and, 10 years ago, mourned his passing. She taught AP English and volunteered at the Career Transitions Center of Chicago. Now she is an Ignatian Volunteer Corps member, one of 65 men and women in Chicago who serve the marginalized. She has spent the last five years leading the Trinity Volunteer Corps, a volunteer site that brings adults with disabilities together through volunteerism at Old St. Patrick's Church in Chicago.

It was her silent retreat at Bellarmine Jesuit Retreat House that clarified her purpose at this juncture in life. "At Bellarmine, I realized God calls you to do different things so many times in your life," says Maureen. "I never thought I'd find myself in my seventies, retired, my husband suddenly gone, life different than I thought it would be and yet firmly believing that God had a purpose for me, a new path to follow and ways to serve. I came to Bellarmine looking for answers and open to hearing God's voice. I discovered in the quiet that there are so many ways God

wants to use us to do good. My retreat helped me open up to the unexpected, what I was being called to next."

Since then, Maureen has attended several silent retreats at Bellarmine and three days a week attends mid-day Mass there.

She says, "Bellarmine gave me a place to look back on my life, to understand what I needed to act on, how to see Christ in the stranger, how to serve with gratitude. Bellarmine offers a special space to encounter God in my daily living."

Her ministry today is inspired by Jesus' call to create a community that welcomes and honors all. At Old St. Patrick's, the group finds purpose in all their work... from folding weekly worship aids and assembling cheer bags for shut-ins, to greeting Mass-goers, assisting at special events, serving meals at the Ronald McDonald Houses, and preparing weekly food bags for the homeless.

"I feel blessed that what I've found at Bellarmine has allowed me to understand more clearly that I need to listen patiently for God's voice and then accept the grace He sends to do all I can to serve others." ✠

## Sacred Spaces

While our renovation project encompasses a wide scope of updates to infrastructure, we are most excited about the two projects below, which enhance our ability to welcome all people of faith to an encounter with the sacred.

### Opening the Door to Hospitality

For folks who use a wheelchair, cane, or other mobility aid, the front entry was challenging to navigate. With a new entrance ramp and raised front patio, all retreatants will be able to enter at the red front door and experience the hospitality of the retreat house staff. Previously, those with mobility aids had to drive around the building and access the retreat house from the lower level.

The front hallway itself is now more accessible as well. The interior arched doorway was widened to be double the size of the original opening, so that folks of all abilities can easily navigate the front hallway.



### Opening the Window to the Sacred

If you've ever stayed in the original manor home wing of the retreat house, you probably saw the old radiators which took up a great deal of space under each window in the retreatant rooms. With a new central air and heating system, we were able to remove the radiators. This allows us to place a comfortable chair near the window in each room.

Now, you'll be able to relax and enjoy the views of God's sacred creation from every retreat room!

### A Challenging Year

2020 has been a challenging year for everyone, to say the least. Between the COVID-19 stay-at-home order and the renovation project, our doors were closed to retreatants from mid-March through August. As a result, we lost about \$120,000 in revenue. There were nearly 900 people we thought we'd serve, but didn't:

- ✘ 6 Kairos Youth Retreats (approx. 345 people)
- ✘ 4 Weekend Retreats (258 people)
- ✘ 8 Special Event Retreats (approx. 225 people)
- ✘ 1 Individually Directed Retreat (approx. 40 people)
- ✘ 1 Veterans Retreat (approx. 20 people)



### Meet Fr. Jim Strzok, SJ

Joining the Ministry Team and Jesuit Community this year is Fr. Jim Strzok, SJ. He comes to us with a varied background ranging from expertise in cosmology, Earth sciences, chemistry and physics to extensive retreat ministry.

Fr. Strzok spent 13 years working with Sioux Indians in South Dakota before beginning a 33-year-long ministry in East Africa. His work there included helping to form religious women and clerics at a spirituality center as well as training religious and lay leaders to give the *Spiritual Exercises* at Mwangaza Retreat Center. In addition, Fr. Strzok oversaw development and buildings for the East African Province, heading up many construction projects.

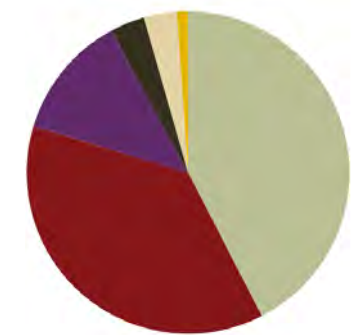
