


St. Ignatius' Daily Examen



The Daily Examen is a technique of prayerful reflection on the events of the day in order to detect God's presence and discern His direction for us. It is a way of reflecting with gratitude on the events and feelings of our day. The method presented here is adapted from a technique described by Ignatius Loyola in his *Spiritual Exercises*. It is a life-changing prayer!



Enter into God's presence. Quiet your mind and heart for prayer.

"Lord, I believe at this moment I am in Your presence, and You love me ... Come, Holy Spirit!"



Offer gratitude to God for the blessings of the day and begin by savoring your gifts.

"Lord, I am grateful for all the ways You have shown Your love for me this day. I especially thank You for ..."



Review the events of your day, noticing specific moments and feelings that surface.

"Lord, help me to recognize You in all parts of my life. Jesus, I want to see ..."



Pray from the feelings that surface. Talk to God as a friend, listening with your heart for God's response of love.

"Lord, You have examined my heart, and You know everything about me..."



Look toward tomorrow in hope, asking for the grace to better serve God. Conclude with an "Our Father."

"Lord, enlighten me so that my future choices praise, reverence, and serve You above all else. Show me Your way."

Thank you for your intentional and generous care of Bellarmine and our retreatants. In this report we share with you our gratitude, our joy, our reflections, and your impact.


A few words about the image of St. Ignatius on the cover. This is an original painting by the gifted artist

Fr. Raymond Fussner, SJ **Retreat Director** 1969-1993

Fr. Fussner's delivery of 7:00am morning prayer has stayed with me for decades. His delivery and gentle messaging struck me then

and stays with me to this day. I distinctly recall him referencing biblical quotes about Jesus' intimate familiarity with each and every one of us. Fr. Fussner prayed so eloquently about how we are always front and center in Jesus' view, how He sees "every hair on our head" and how our "name is written on His palm." He spoke eloquently about the indelible mark of Jesus on our hand. I love this image of Jesus that Fr. Fussner shared with the retreatants. He is remembered as a gifted Jesuit whose morning prayer ran the perfect 5-minute time allotment. We were never late for breakfast!

Fr. Patrick Boyle, SJ Executive Director 1972-1982

Fr. Pat Boyle, SJ had a unique rapport with the Bellarmine retreatants, and he developed close friendships with many of us. Fr.

Pat was a Green Beret in Vietnam and many weekends he would walk around the retreat house in his military fatigues so he was ready to go, if needed, to serve in the National Guard. He was a wonderful confessor and personally very spiritual. He always exhibited a tough exterior but was really a soft-hearted guy. While serving as Executive Director, he completed a doctorate in moral theology from Marquette University. Fr. Boyle now resides at the Jesuit Retirement Center in Wauwatosa, WI, where he continues praying for the needs of the Church and the Society of Jesus.



Fr. John Dillon, SJ **Executive Director** 1999-2006

Fr. Dillon is often remembered for his language, which could be "colorful," and for his honesty, which could be

withering. But there are two things I remember most about him: a question he asked and the attitudes which guided his prayer life. Fr. Dillon's question, which could be applied to both the good times and bad, was "Where is God in your experiences?" The attitudes that guided his prayer life were gratitude and trust. He always had gratitude for the circumstances that life presented to him, and he always trusted that the Lord was loving him in those circumstances. I have not found a better way to approach my spiritual life.


Ministry Team Reflections



Serving Bellarmine and Others

I am now in my 12th year on the retreat staff here at Bellarmine. But my association with the retreat house goes back to the early 1970s, when I made my first retreat here. At that

time I also attended Jesuit meetings in the exciting era when we claimed the new developments of Vatican II for the Society of Jesus and its ministries. In the 1990s, I represented the Jesuit Provincial for our Midwest Province as planning got underway for what is now our Conference Center. For the past five years it has been a pleasure to serve on Bellarmine's Board as we renovated our original manor building and carried through a successful capital campaign. All of this bodes well for our future of serving the spiritual needs of the many people who come to Bellarmine Jesuit Retreat House.









Walking the Halls of Bellarmine

Sometimes on Sunday evenings after retreatants have departed, I take a walk from the Jesuit Residence through the empty buildings of the retreat house. It's a walk through many personal memories for me.

My memories lead me from the original

manor house that has recently been remodeled, through the 1959 addition, and on to the Conference Center that was completed in 2003. I walk past the offices that originally housed the kitchen and butler's pantry, and where the maids' stairway used to come down from the 3rd floor. That space then became the Retreat Director's bedroom and conference room and 2 or 3 guest rooms before becoming the office space as we know it today.





I walk through the Fireplace Room and remember it as the first Chapel and the original end of the building. Below that was the dining room (now the Resource Center), which brings memories of my time as a seminarian serving the meals to retreatants who ate at small linen covered tables.

As I walk through the middle section of the building, often visiting the Sacred Heart and Fogarty Chapels, I am reminded of the many retreatants and benefactors who have, through their generosity, made all of this possible. I thank the Good Lord for these past 14 years and my time as one of the Jesuit Priests in residence at Bellarmine.








A Bold Encounter with God

Beginning a retreat could be like rowing out to the depths to engage Christ who encounters us in the deep.






