LETTER FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR



I am finding that words are not nearly adequate to describe the graces of Bellarmine's June pilgrimage to Spain in the footsteps of St. Ignatius. I imagine that you can recall a time or experience that is beyond description. Being a pilgrim and praying at the sites

where Ignacio Loyola prayed was one of those times for me. For 12 days I was refashioned, my heart imprinted and enthralled, my soul absorbed in the trail of the faithful and in communion with 49 other captivated believers.

I beseech you, schedule your next retreat, invite a few friends, and consider how God is inviting you to make a pilgrimage. Being a pilgrim is like nothing else in life, and like a retreat, is an extraordinary encounter with the Divine.



Assists the Provincial in caring for Jesuits in the Midwest Province awaiting final vows and for the Province's senior Jesuits who are 70 or older.




EXPERIENCING GOD THROUGH IGNATIAN CONTEMPLATION AND PRAYER

National speaker on trauma-informed care, youth formation, Ignatian spirituality and leadership; previous high school teacher and associate pastor.








ENTERING HOLY WEEK THROUGH THE SPIRITUAL EXERCISES
