Members of the Council on Ministries for Bethel UMC include chairpersons/representative for Evangelism, Missions, Stewardship, Education/Family Ministries (Young Adult and Older Adult), Youth Representative, Worship, Higher Education/Campus Ministries, Church and Society, Bereavement, Health and Welfare, Older Adult Ministries, Younger Adult Ministries, Children's Coordinator, Lay Visitation Coordinator and Scouting Ministries.

The Council on Ministries meets 3rd Monday, 6:00 PM bi-monthly beginning in January with called meetings as necessary.

The Council on Ministries Chair serves on the Administrative Board which meets 4th Monday, 6:00 PM bi-monthly beginning in January with called meetings as necessary.
