TRADITIONAL WORSHIP/SPECIAL SERVICES MINISTRY TEAM Ministry Position Description Bethel United Methodist Church (Updated 9/1/2009)

The Traditional Worship/Special Services Ministry Team has responsibility for planning, implementing, and evaluating the various traditional worship opportunities offered at Bethel. This is a three-year commitment. The Chair works closely with the pastor, the choir director, and the organist.

Specific Responsibilities:

- ◆ To set goals based on the goals set by the Church Council and the mission statement of the church
- ◆ To plan and implement worship opportunities, and lead an on-going evaluation of the same opportunities.
- ♦ To develop a budget for the Finance Committee/Church Council each year, based on the needs of the altar guild, ushers, communion stewards, and acolytes, as well as special services, i.e. Homecoming/Festival of Faith.

Training

Ideally, the first year is mentored by members of the committee who have served longer than one year, and training opportunities are available through publications and literature, as well as direction from the senior pastor.

The Worship Committee meets on the first Wednesday of January, April, July and October at 6 p.m.
