

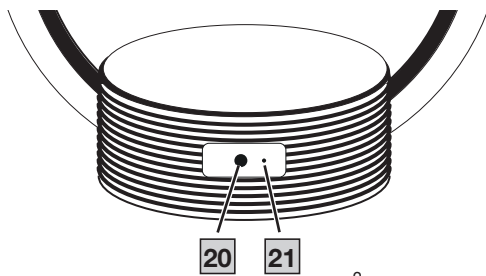
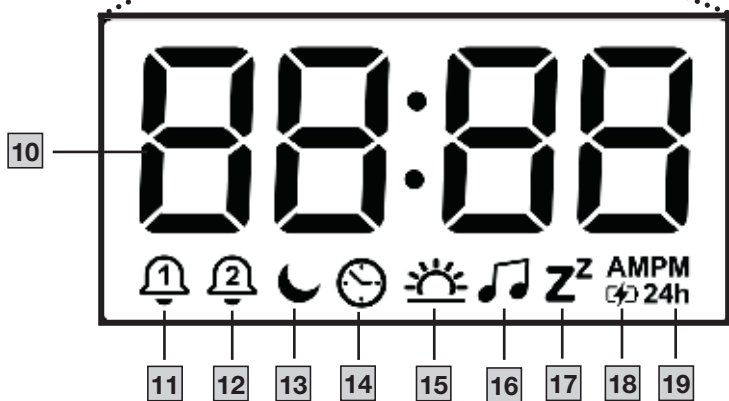
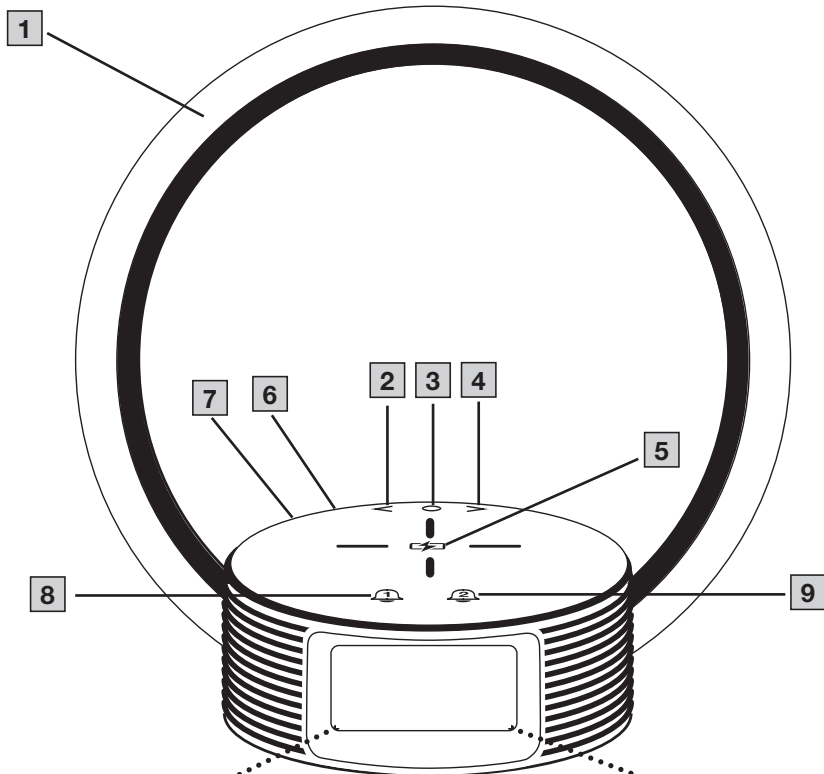

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1. INCLUDED IN DELIVERY

Check that the exterior of the cardboard delivery packaging is intact and make sure that all contents are present. Before use, ensure that there is no visible damage to the device and the supplied components and that all packaging material has been removed. If you have any doubts, do not use the device and contact your retailer or the specified Customer Service address.

▲ WARNING

- The device is only intended for domestic/private use, not for commercial use.
- This device may be used by children over the age of 8 and by people with reduced physical, sensory or mental skills or a lack of experience or knowledge, provided that they are supervised or have been instructed on how to use the device safely, and are fully aware of the consequent risks of use.

6. USAGE

6.1 Initial use

1. Remove the packaging material.
2. Check that all parts listed are present.
3. Check the device and mains cable for damage.
4. Place the device on a firm, even surface.
5. Place the device near an easily accessible socket.
6. Connect the mains adapter to the mains adapter connection **6** on the back of the device.
7. Insert the mains adapter into a suitable socket.
↳ The time "0:00" appears on the device display for two minutes, and "24h" flashes. 
8. Use the < > buttons to set your preferred hour format ("24h" for 24-hour format or "AM/PM" for 12-hour format).
9. Confirm by pressing the O button.
↳ The time in hours flashes on the display.
10. Use the < > buttons to set the time in hours. Confirm by pressing the O button.
↳ The time in minutes flashes on the display.
11. Use the < > buttons to set the time in minutes. Confirm by pressing the O button.
↳ "End" appears on the display. The time is now set and the device is ready for operation.

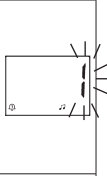
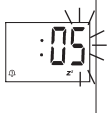
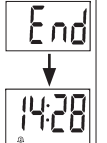
 If it is not possible to set the time, refer to the "Setting the time" chapter.

6.2 Setting the alarm (with wake-up function and sunrise)

You can set a colour sunrise and an alarm tone for the alarm. If this is selected, the light ring **1** simulates the sun's colour sunrise (red – orange – yellow – white light). In addition, an invigorating alarm tone can be selected (6 sounds available) – for a gentle, energising start to the day.

The device has two alarm memory spaces ( and ) to which you assign different alarm times.

| 2. Use the < > buttons to set the alarm hour. Confirm by pressing the O button. |  |

| 3. Use the < > buttons to set the alarm minute. Confirm by pressing the O button. |  |
| ↳ The sunrise icon 15 appears on the display and "no" flashes. | |
| 4. Use the < > buttons to set the duration of the sunrise to ("no", 05, 10, 15 or 30 minutes). Confirm by pressing the O button. | |
| The set time defines how long the sunrise simulation takes before the wake-up time starts in order to support a gentle waking-up process. At the end of the simulation, the alarm starts with the selected alarm tone. |  |

↳ The music icon 16 appears on the display and “no” flashes. 5. Use the < > buttons to set your preferred wake-up sound (“no”, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6). While you are setting it, you will receive a preview of the melody. Use the O button to confirm.	
↳ The snooze icon 17 appears on the display and the number “05” flashes. 6. Use the < > buttons to set the snooze duration (05, 10, 15, 20, 25 or 30 minutes, “no”). Confirm by pressing the O button.	
↳ “End” appears on the display. The normal time will then appear. The Alarm1 icon 11 also lights up under the time. The alarm is now set and activated.	

6.3 Switching off the alarm

You can either snooze or turn off the sounding alarm.

- To snooze the alarm, briefly touch the light ring **1**. The alarm then sounds again after the set snooze duration.
- To switch off the sounding alarm, touch the light ring **1** for three seconds. The set alarm will then only sound again the next day.

6.4 Activating/deactivating the alarm

To activate or deactivate a preset Alarm1 or Alarm2, briefly press the Alarm1 button **8** or Alarm2 button **9**, depending on which alarm you want to select.

↳ The Alarm1 icon **11** or the Alarm2 icon **9** disappears or appears on the display. The alarm is now activated/deactivated.

6.5 Sleep function/sunset

You can set a colour sunset on the device. If this is selected, the light ring **1** simulates the colours of sunset (white – yellow – orange – red light). In addition, a gentle sleep melody (5 sounds available) can be selected to help you relax as you fall asleep.

1. Press the **O** button **3**.
2. The sleep symbol **13** appears on the display.
3. Press the **O** button **3**.

↳ “05” will start to flash on the display.
4. Use the **<** **>** buttons to set the duration of the sunset (5, 10, 15 or 30 minutes). Confirm by pressing the **O** button.

↳ The music icon **16** appears on the display and the number “00” flashes.
5. Use the **<** **>** buttons to set your preferred sleep melody (00, 1, 2, 3, 4 or 5). Confirm by pressing the **O** button.

↳ “End” appears on the display. The sleep function is now activated and the light ring **1** slowly becomes darker over the set time, simulating a sunset.



Alternatively, this function can be started by pressing and holding the **O** button (without previous setting)

6.6 Setting the time

1. Press the **O** button **3** and the right arrow button **>**.

↳ The time symbol **14** appears in the display.
2. Press the **O** button **3**.

↳ “24h” starts flashing on the display.
3. Use the **<** **>** buttons to set your preferred hour format (“24h” for 24-hour format, or “AM/PM” for 12-hour format).
4. Confirm by pressing the **O** button.

↳ The time in hours flashes on the display.
5. Use the **<** **>** buttons to set the time in hours. Confirm by pressing the **O** button.

↳ The time in minutes flashes on the display.
6. Use the **<** **>** buttons to set the time in minutes. Confirm by pressing the **O** button.

↳ “End” appears on the display. The time is now set.

6.7 Setting the display brightness

The device has a total of 5 different display brightness levels (100%, 50%, 25%, 1%, off).

- Use the **<** **>** buttons to set your preferred display brightness.

6.8 Lamp/mood light

The light ring **1** can also be used as a lamp/mood light. The device has nine different settings.

1. To use the light ring **1** as a lamp/mood light, briefly tap on the light ring frame **1**.

↳ The light ring **1** lights up in white.
2. To switch between the nine different mood lights, briefly tap on the frame of the light ring **1**.

white → bright colour change fast → bright colour change slow → orange → red → purple → blue → petrol → green → light ring off
3. To increase or decrease the brightness of the mood light, press and hold the frame of the light ring **1**. The light intensity first increases and then decreases. When the correct setting is reached, lift your finger off the illuminated ring. This setting is now retained.
4. After 5 seconds in the selected setting, you can switch off the light ring by briefly tapping the light ring frame.

6.9 Charging a smartphone

This device uses the official Qi standard for inductive charging. This ensures energy efficiency, interoperability and safety during inductive charging. For example, the 10W fast charging station fully charges a 3000 mAh battery in approx. 2.5 hours.

⚠ CAUTION

- Risk of overheating! Never cover the device with objects or textiles when a smartphone is being charged inductively.
- Never place EC cards, credit cards, other cards with magnetic stripes or magnetically sensitive objects on the charging surface **5** of the device.
- Make sure that there are no parts that contain metal on the back of your smartphone (such as a magnetic holder). Inductive charging can cause the metal to heat up significantly and cause irreparable damage to the device and smartphone.
- Mobile phone cases or covers can slow down the charging process or prevent it completely.



To charge your smartphone on the wake-up light, your smartphone model must support inductive charging.

1. To charge the smartphone, place it in the centre of the smartphone charging surface **[5]**. The charging icon for the smartphone **[18]** appears on the display.
2. The smartphone is now being inductively charged.

6.10 Resetting to factory settings

- To reset the device to the factory settings, use a pointed object to press and hold the reset button for three seconds.

7. CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

▲ WARNING

- Clean the device with a dry cloth.
- Ensure that no water enters the device.
- If this does happen, only reuse the device once it has fully dried out.
- Never immerse the device or mains adapter plug in water or other liquids.

NOTICE

- Protect the device from knocks, damp, dust, chemicals, severe temperature fluctuations and nearby sources of heat (ovens, heaters).
- Do not use any abrasive cleaning products.

8. WHAT IF THERE ARE PROBLEMS?

Problem	Possible cause	Solution
Device does not light up	No power	Plug the mains adapter into a suitable socket.
	No power	The mains adapter is faulty. Contact Customer Services or your retailer.
	LEDs have reached the end of their service life. LEDs faulty.	For repairs, please contact Customer Services or an authorised retailer.

9. DISPOSAL

For environmental reasons, do not dispose of the device in household waste at the end of its service life. Dispose of the device at a suitable local collection or recycling point in your country.
