1 May: Rwanda

Pray for the *Jesus. All About Life* campaign in Rwanda, aiming to mobilise churches to reach their communities with the gospel, and serving as a healing tool for people suffering trauma. Thank God that African Enterprise is helping people experience a personal relationship with Jesus and pray for the planned workshops and outreach events.

2 May: Australia

Please pray for the Auslan Bible translation project, for God's continued guidance as the committee regularly meet and make plans. Pray too for more team members, especially for more Deaf translators. Pray for good health for the team, and God's protection over them as they grow this ministry to the Australian Deaf community.

3 May: Global - United Bible Societies

Thank God for literacy work taking place worldwide through Bible Society, and for the Global Literacy Coordination project run by the United Bible Societies (UBS) Global Mission team which continues to provide support for the work. Pray for their plans to develop regional strategies this year, and that they may effectively support French and Spanish-speaking Bible Societies. Pray also for the Literary Officers as they uphold the work.

4 May: Nicaragua

Pray for the Bibles distributed to kids with cancer through the 'Hope and Smile for Children with Cancer' project run by the Bible Society of Nicaragua. Thank God too for the regular spiritual support provided, and that these families have been given the opportunity to know his word. Pray they will continue to seek God in prayer and trust him in every situation.

5 May: Word for the Week

6 May: Syria

Please pray for the Bible Society in Syria, running a trauma-healing program through specialised training seminars and workshops within churches. Pray for stability in the country to allow the program to run, and for all coordinators, trainers and participants, that they would all be strengthened and sustained by God and his word as they work together for healing.

7 May: Australia

Thank God that many people, in hospitals, prisons, camps, and other places of need ask for a visit from a Christian chaplain, and receive God's words of comfort and love. Pray that many will visit dedicated chapel spaces, seeking to hear about the good news of Jesus. Pray that any Bible or Scripture resource they receive will touch their heart, and lead to them embracing the message of Jesus.

8 May: Sri Lanka

Pray for the translation of the Gospel Parables of Jesus into Sign Language for the deaf community in Sri Lanka. This community is marginalised due to the lack of Sign Language interpretation support. Pray for the current editing and recording of the 'Life Story of Jesus' series, and thank God for how these resources will bless the deaf community.



9 May: Australia

Thank God for the vital partnership between Bible Society Australia (BSA) and faithful supporters. Please pray that BSA's fundraising team will continue to build relationships with Bible Society supporters, developing deep and meaningful relationships which honour God and see his work carried out in Australia and around the world.

10 May: Kenya

Pray for the launch of a teen trauma-healing program — 'Arise' led by Bible Society Kenya. This program will train teachers, peer counsellors and parents to support adolescents dealing with trauma. Pray for the willingness of the Church to go out into schools and for the teens in Kenya, that they will find healing and hope in the word of God.

11 May: Kenya

Please pray with Layla*, who is helping with Bible Society Kenya's 'Arise – Healing Teens' Wounds of Trauma' program. She shares, "This project seeks to call back to life the resilience of teenagers, enabling them to overcome the pain of traumatic experiences and move on to achieve their set goals and dreams. These teens will in turn encourage their peers through peer counselling activities."

12 May: Word for the Week

13 May: Australia

Please pray for the Bible Society Australia (BSA) publishing team as they prepare the new Big Rescue Gospel of Mark for release to BSA's mission partners in August 2024. Please pray that the content being developed will support children as they read the Bible, and will enrich their understanding and love of God and his word.

14 May: Burkina Faso

Pray for Bible Society Burkina Faso, and the women's literacy program they are running, which seeks to build reading, writing, socio-economic skills and spiritual growth, as well as helping with income-generating skills. Pray that the classes continue to inspire the women to learn, and transform their lives for the better.

15 May: Australia

Pray for the ministry of Koorong as it continues to equip Christians and churches with Chrisitan resources. Please pray that every Christian resource and Bible distributed through Koorong stores would equip, bless and edify individuals, ministries and churches.

16 May: Laos

18 May: Laos

Please pray with Pastor Cho* for Christians in Laos. He sees the need for a literacy program in his community: "As a church leader, I can see that Hmong believers who cannot read do not engage in Sunday services. They can only sit and listen to the leader and other members, but are hardly able to understand."

19 May: Word for the Week

20 May: Mongolia

Thank God for the Jesus. All About Life campaign in Mongolia. In collaboration with the Mongolian Evangelical Association and Ulaanbaatar city pastors, the project will unite churches to spread the gospel and bring people to faith in Jesus. Pray that the gospel of Christ will reach all Mongolians, such as nomadic ethnic groups and younger generations.

21 May: Australia

Thank God for First Nations Bible translators learning Bible translation at the Nungalinya College in Darwin. Please continue to pray for God's guidance, inspiration, and wisdom especially to newly trained Bible translators as they progress the work of Bible translation in their heart languages.



22 May: Nicaragua

Thank God for 9-year-old Juan*, a beneficiary of the 'Hope and Smiles for Children with Cancer' project in Nicaragua: "Having my own Bible makes me feel happy. The Bible gives me hope because I am going to be healthy. In the future, I hope to be with my friends."

23 May: Australia
