Why a fund?

We know from experience, that for communities and residents to access funding to get their ideas off the ground can often be hard, so we created this fund to be accessible and easy to apply, whilst providing support to residents throughout the process.

Who can apply?

Individual residents can apply, or a group of residents can come together to apply, as well as organisations working with Lancaster West Estate residents.

Why ask us?

We know that residents often have the best ideas and solutions for their communities. So we wanted to ask you what ideas you had for how the fund could be used. The ideas you shared have now formed the fund's themes and criteria.





What's the fund's aim?

The number one aim of the fund is to benefit Lancaster West Estate residents. So each application must have that at its core. We have built the criteria for the fund based on the ideas residents told us, so each application must now fall under those themes.

Who decides?

Every fund must have a decision making process and panel. The panel includes two members of the Residents Association, two members from Karakusevic Carson Architects and two members of the Lancaster West Neighbourhood Team.
