An active approach to reading *HRM: A Critical Approach*

Developed by an American education philosopher Francis Robinson, **SQ3R** is a reading technique that will help you comprehend the material in *HRM: A Critical Approach*. **SQ3R** has five steps: **S**urvey, **Q**uestion, **R**ead, **R**ecall, and **R**eview.

1. Step 1: **Survey** or scan a chapter before you read it. Note the headings, sub-headings, figures, tables, images and captions, summary paragraphs, and reflective questions. This survey step typically will only take you 5 minutes, but it provides an outline for what will be presented.
2. Step 2: **Questions** should be generated about the content of the chapter. The reflective questions embedded in each chapter are designed to help you do this. Another way to formulate questions is to convert headings or sub-headings into questions, and then look for answers in the content of the text. For example, the heading 'The Employment Relationship' can be converted to: 'Why is the employment relationship important in HRM?' Other more general questions may be formulated from the review questions at the end of the chapter.
3. Step 3: **Read** the chapter using the preliminary work done in steps 1 & 2 to begin reading purposefully. This means actively reading in order to answer the questions raised in step 2. Passive reading, in contrast, is reading without engaging with the chapter material.
4. Step 4: **Recall** from memory what you have learned in the same manner as telling someone else about the chapter content. It is important that you use your own words in order to formulate and internalize the material. Try recalling key points and answers to questions from Step 2. The recall step may be done either in an oral or written format.
5. Step 5: **Review** the chapter learning objectives and then the relevant material by repeating back to yourself what the point of each section is using your own words. Ask yourself, 'Have I achieved the learning outcomes?' You may then repeat the process on the second set of learning outcomes or questions.
